

# Essential skills when playing FPP mode in PUBG Mobile

Some tips will help you observe and control characters better in FPP PUBG Mobile mode

Between the two modes of FPP and TPP in PUBG Mobile, many gamers will definitely choose the TPP viewpoint because in this mode, gamers have more advantages in observation than in FPP perspective. But FPP also has highlights that attract many gamers who have played through FPS titles.

If you are playing TPP mode but want to switch to FPP, you must pay attention to some skills needed when playing this first-person view mode. Especially when fighting situations, refer to some of the necessary skills if you want to switch to FPP mode in PUBG Mobile.

## Skills must be available when playing FPP PUBG Mobile mode

### 1. Defense skills



The big problem of FPP players is that everyone can see that is the perspective, with TPP view, the character's vision will be much wider than FPP. In the FPP perspective, the player will be greatly reduced, for example, in this picture, if it is in TPP mode, the character's view will expand in the front window.

Therefore, if FPP players want to observe correctly, they will have to move more than TPP regime. If you are in the house and have to defend, then it will be inconvenient because you will have to move constantly to observe those who are on the house.

Outside enemies can hear your footsteps and determine where you are standing in the house, they will throw grenades and you will have to listen to grenades and collisions to avoid. So, whoever plays FPP mode, the advice is to use a headset with good sound, pay attention to what is around you and remember, limit movement and just listen while you are in the home.

## 2. Observation skills



Viewing at FPP perspective compared to TPP when being equipped with Scope or Red dot or Holo is not much different, even when watching vegetarian. The advantage of FPP over TPP is that the player's vision will be closer.

Although the view is not as wide as the TPP but the vision will be closer, and every movement in front of your eyes will be easier to find than FPP, so this will be a plus point for you to watch faster.

## 3. Driving skills



In the TPP perspective, you will observe a wide angle of view while driving and moving characters. At FPP you will only be able to see a narrow angle while driving the same car as the character, but don't worry because you can turn to the side to observe.



However, you are still limited when watching while driving, you will not know who is chasing after you behind. You can only recognize it by the wheel icon moving on the map, so the advice is to follow your teammates while playing Squad or stopping, jumping out and receiving guests behind are rushing to ok

Here are a few tips to help you control better in FPP mode, besides controlling characters and paying attention to observing you also need to coordinate more with your teammates. Some team types will make it easier for you to win the TOP 1 in the game if you get to know them and stand next to them, refer to the article PUBG Mobile VNG: The types of teammates will help you spend the top 1 to know which teammates should coordinate
