1. Driver for device

Although the Windows 7 operating system has helped users save a lot of time in finding the right driver so that the computer can 'identify' each connected device such as sound card, video card, and computer. print, Internet . But if you're still using Windows XP, you'll need a large amount of disk drivers to install for your device.

Perhaps there is no need to talk too much about the role of the Web browser for users. This is an application software that allows users to view and interact with documents, images, video clips, music, games and other information on a web site of a global web address. or intranet.

At the present time, with almost uniform quality, the choice of which internet browser to use may not be too different: Chrome, Firefox, Internet Explorer, Opera or Safari, all have adequate speed. Amazingly, it is accompanied by the ability to integrate tools and useful plug-ins.

5. Chat software
