Opal is a precious mineral rarer than rubies and diamonds, so more and more people flock here to exploit and create many hollow holes in the ground. Exploitation area is expanded and more and more big houses are built.

The temporary construction houses have been repaired and decorated quite comfortably like other houses on the ground from bed, living room, wardrobe, television, cooking stove . People here water use is led from a 24km underground underground source located north of the town.



Sandstone is the main material for building houses in the ground because it is easy to exploit, has stability and stability. In addition, the beautiful color of sandstone also brings elegance, warmth to the space inside the house, in stark contrast to the harshness of the weather outside the desert.

Each house has a narrow vertical axis for ventilation to all rooms. Especially the kitchen and living room are illuminated with natural light thanks to a light shaft. The bedroom is arranged in the back of the house to keep quiet. The houses in the earth always have a stable temperature of about 24 degrees Celsius and 20% humidity.
