I. Summary of Photoshop shortcuts to understand

Photoshop shortcuts are many, with a variety of purposes. Below are each group of keyboard shortcuts categorized by function. Let's update now!



Shortcut Key PHOTOSHOP



1. Shortcuts to help edit photos in Photoshop

When performing photo editing, you can apply the following operations:

+ Create selection: CODE key

+ Move: V key

- + Make a selection by color: W . key
- + Crop image: SIZE key
- + Create a free selection: L key
- + Ruler, color dots: I . key
- + Erase, delete: E . key
- +Sampling from images: SHOULD key
- + Drawing tools, brush strokes, coloring: REMOVE key
- + Restore all previous image parameters: Y . key
- + Fill color: WOOD key
- + Select direction, road: A key
- + Create vector, draw lines: P key
- + Darken the image: O . key
- + Create text: key
- + Draw ellipses, rectangles, lines,...: U . key
- + Default color: EASY key
- + Rotate: R Zoom in or out: Z . key
- + View photos when zoomed in too much: HOUSE key
- + Reduce brush size: [
- + Increase brush size:]
- + Quick Mask mode: Q
- + Convert color between Foreground and Background: X
- + Toggle Preserve Transparency: /
- + Change the screen mode: F
- + Select the first brush:
- + Select the previous brush: ,
- + Select the next brush: .
- + Select the last brush: >

2. Groups of shortcuts to manipulate Layers in Photoshop

When performing layer operations, there are some basic Photoshop keyboard shortcuts:

- + CTRL + SHIFT + N: Create new
- + CTRL + SHIFT + J: Cut
- + CTRL + J: Duplicate Layer
- + CTRL + SHIFT + G: Ungroup Layer
- + Layer CTRL + G: Create a Layer group
- + CTRL +]: Move Layer up
- + CTRL + SHIFT +]: Move Layer to the top
- + CTRL + SHIFT + [: Move Layer to the bottom
- + CTRL + [: Move the layer down
- + CTRL + SHIFT + E: Merge all layers
- + CTRL + E: Merge selected layers

3. Photoshop Shortcuts Related to File

When performing File saving, File editing, or all File-related operations, the following shortcuts can be performed:

- + Create a new File: Ctrl + N
- + Edit on the reading page: Shift + Ctrl + W
- + Open File: Ctrl + O
- + Close the open file: Ctrl + W
- + Close all open files: Alt + Ctrl + W
- + Save File: Ctrl + WILL
- + Save as web: Alt + Shift + Ctrl + WILL
- + Save it as: Shift + Ctrl + S or Alt + Ctrl + WILL
- + View File information: Alt + Shift + Ctrl + I
- + Exit the software: Ctrl + Q
- + Page settings: Alt + Shift + Ctrl + P

+ Restore original image: F12 . key

4. Photoshop Shortcuts for Editing

Performing the Edit function will have some of the following operations:

+ Redo, Undo: Ctrl + Z

+ Return to the next action: Shift + Ctrl + Z

+ Return to the previous action: Alt + Ctrl + Z

+ Cut: Ctrl + X or F2

+ Fade: Shift + Ctrl + F

+ Paste: Ctrl + V or F4

+ Copy Merged: Shift + Ctrl + C

+ Copy: Ctrl + C or F3

+ Open the Fill dialog box: Shift + F5

+ Paste Into: Shift + Ctrl + DRAW

+ Rotate freely, stretch: Ctrl + T

5. Photoshop Shortcuts That Perform Settings

To install, you can use some simple Photoshop shortcuts as follows:

+ General settings: Ctrl + K

+ Menu settings: Alt + Shift + Ctrl + CODE

+ Keyboard shortcut settings: Alt + Shift + Ctrl + KEY combination

+ Color settings: Shift + Ctrl + KEY combination

6. Shortcut keys to perform display function

For display related functions, you can perform the following photoshop shortcuts:

+ Target Path: Shift + Ctrl + SHIFT key combination

+ Toggle Guides: Ctrl + ;

+ Toggle the grid: Ctrl + ' key combination

+ Toggle the ruler: Ctrl + LOW

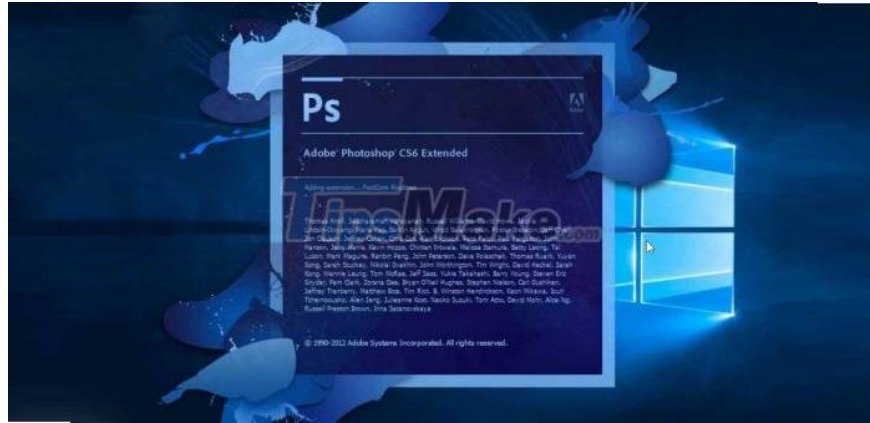
- + Turn on and off the Actions panel: Alt + F9 . key combination
- + Lock Guides: Alt + Ctrl + key combination;
- + Snap: Shift + Ctrl + ;
- + Turn on and off the Color palette: F6 . key
- + Turn on and off the Layer panel: F7 . key
- + Turn on and off the Brushes panel: F5 . key
- + Zoom out: Ctrl + -
- + Turn on and off the Info panel: F8 . key
- + Zoom in: Ctrl + +
- + Zoom in 100%: Alt + Ctrl + 0
- + Full display on the screen: Ctrl + 0

7. Shortcuts to perform the Select function in Photoshop

To select, or deselect, the Select functions in Photoshop, you can perform the following keyboard shortcuts:

- + Select all: Ctrl + A
- + Select again: Shift + Ctrl +
- + Deselect: Ctrl +
- + Invert selection: Shift + F7 or Shift + Ctrl + I
- + Blur the border of the selection: Alt + Ctrl + D or Shift + F6
- + Select all layers: Alt + Ctrl + A

II. Why is it important to remember keyboard shortcuts in Photoshop?



If you want to do professional Photoshop work, you need to remember keyboard shortcuts. Because it will help the operations become fast, without having to move the mouse. From there, helping to increase work efficiency, showing professionalism in the Photoshop profession.

In fact, there are so many shortcuts that it is quite difficult to memorize. However, once you get used to it, it becomes a lot simpler. So, try to memorize from basic to advanced keyboard shortcuts to improve your skills!
