

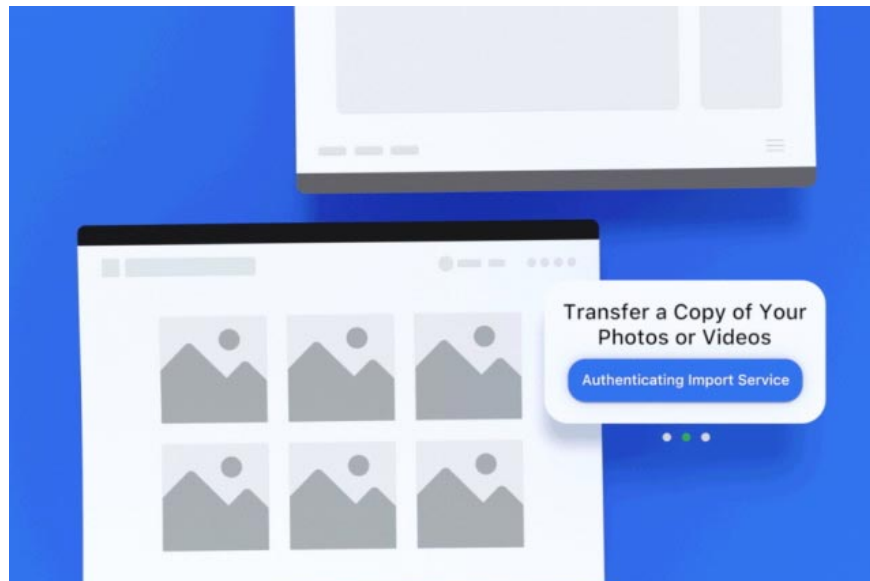
Facebook added a feature that allows users to transfer images directly to Google Photos

This data sharing feature is currently being piloted by Facebook in Ireland before being widely updated in the first half of 2020.

Facebook has now begun deploying a feature that allows users to move images directly from the platform to Google Photos as part of a shared data sharing agreement signed by both companies since the end of July. At the same time, the decision was made just two months after the social media giant published a white list of how to solve some of the key issues around ensuring connectivity in mobile data sharing. between online services that are in common use today.
