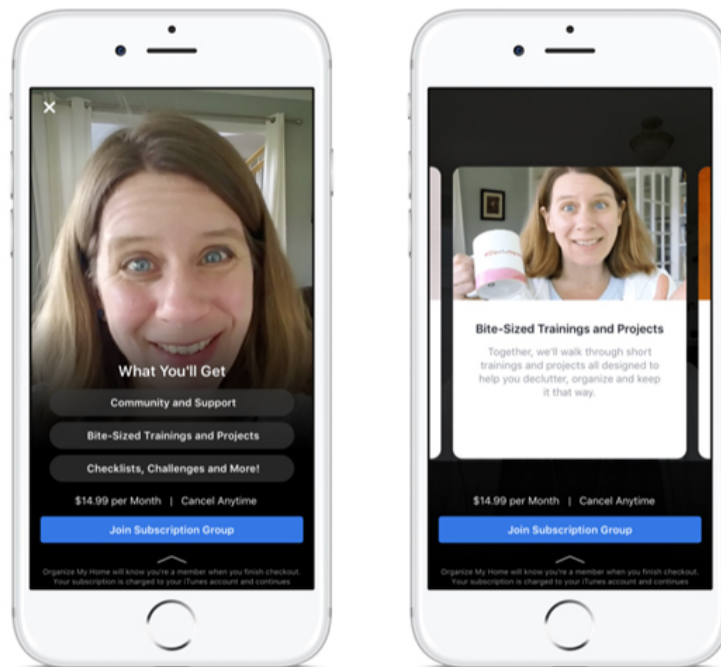


# Facebook allows administrators to collect membership fees from the Group from 4.99 to 29.99 USD / month
