

Facebook host file, How to edit the host file on facebook 2017

How to access facebook by editing the latest host file. Detailed instructions on how to fix the host file, fix the error that the host file cannot be saved. Update the latest host file!

In the previous article, I mentioned 5 **ways** to access **Facebook** , so if you haven't read it yet, please review it to understand it better! This next post I guide in detail on 1 of which is: edit the host file into facebook. Also you will always find the latest **facebook host file** updated at this Topic!

Among the **ways to access facebook when blocked** , in my **opinion** , how to **fix the host file** is the most used way, also the way to access Facebook without slowing down the network speed.

For those of you who already know how to **fix the hosts file** , you can use one of the three IP ranges below to copy and replace the old IP range in your computer.

1. **If the host file cannot be found:** Download the host file 'here' or here, extract and Paste it into the folder:
C: // Windows / system 32 / drives / etc

2. How to fix the host file on facebook

Find the following path: **C: WindowsSystem32driversetc** . Find the file named **hosts** . Right-click and select Open with, then select **Notepad** . **Copy the IP range above** and replace the old IP range, or add new by copying and Paste below # :: 1 localhost. As shown below:

1. **Then save.** If a dialog box appears, it means that you do not have permission to save that host file. => Continue reading below - error could not save host.

3. Error saving host file:

Method 1 : 'Recommended this method' **Use Take Ownership** . Effect of admin rights on the machine, help you can arbitrarily change the host file content.

1. Download Take Ownership here.
2. Run `installtakeownership.reg` to install.
3. Click on your host file => Select Take Ownership.
4. Change the content, then save easily. 100% success.

Method 2: First, **turn off the anti-virus software** installed on your computer! Because I am interfering with the operating system files.

1. Access the following path: **C: WindowsSystem32driversetc** . Find the file named **hosts** . Right-click and select Properties.

The interface will look like this: **Uncheck Read only** box if available. Then select **Tab Security** .

Next you follow the instructions below:

After that, you can **Ctrl + S** to save the host file you just copied. You should turn it back on and see if it really saves it!

Used in parallel with **how to fix the host file** , you should combine **DNS changes** to best effect.
