Facebook, the social network with the most users in the world, has always been a favorite target for hackers. If users do not use secure security methods, not paying attention, it is very easy for bad guys to steal accounts and use them for bad purposes.

Use easy-to-guess passwords

Many people have the habit of setting a password that is easy to guess such as the date of birth, their name or the serial number sequence 123456 . With these passwords, someone who knows or learns a little information about you can easy to guess so it's easy to reveal.



In addition, we often set short passwords that are easy to remember, only use letters in the dictionary, do not use complex symbols and numbers. This also makes it easy for hackers to steal your account.

Do not use two-step authentication method

The best way to protect your Facebook account is to implement Two-Factor Authentication. This means that each time you log in to Facebook, in addition to the usual password, users will have to enter the confirmation code sent directly to the phone. It takes a bit of time, but this can help you protect your account very safely.



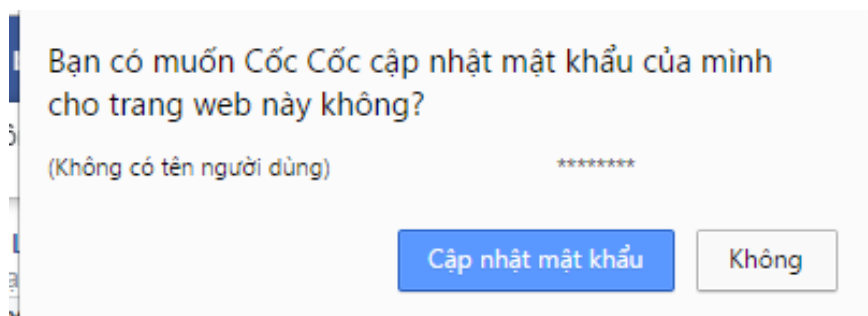
Click all links

Links (links) are the most common way to 'trick' users into clicking on malicious websites. Links can be sent via e-mail, text messages, pop-up advertisements, fake login websites designed as real. If you don't notice, anyone will be 'tricked' and easily give your Facebook account and personal information to the bad guys.

Ignore the warning signs

Ignoring the unwanted access alerts to your account, following the password reset e-mail that you didn't ask yourself, or your Facebook reporter with a strange status is also very easy to lose your account.

Habit of saving login password

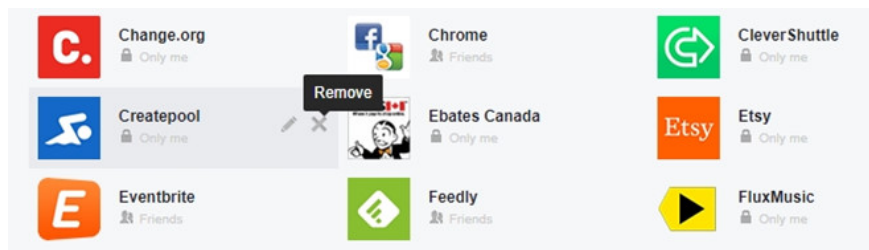


Many people are afraid to enter their password every time they open Facebook or any other personal account, so choose the memo 'Remember Me'. But with computers in public places like schools, friends' houses . your account is easily accessible by anyone.

Change your password regularly

Frequently changing your password is easy to confuse, forgetting to remember it, so it is easy to lead a simple password. So, think carefully, choose a long password, full of letters, numbers and special characters to ensure safety and long-term use.

Connecting indiscriminate applications



Social network accounts now often have the ability to connect to apps and games for the convenience of users, but this is potentially a very high risk of insecurity. When using these applications, you must provide access to personal information, contact lists . If you accept them, you have accidentally 'given' your account to the 'mouth' for the bad guy.

Lose your e-mail account

We usually only use a single e-mail address to log in to all online sites including social networks, job sites, financial services, banks . otherwise this e-mail address is Stolen by bad guys, all of your accounts are lost as well.

You will not be able to retrieve the stolen e-mail password without using the two-step authentication method, not answering personal information questions, not using the service provider's security enhancement tools. e-mail service.
