Currently, Facebook has not given any special rights to donate people, but the social networking giant is developing various options for both streamer and gamers. For example, to thank fans who donate, players can send them a special emoji Reaction, floating on the stream.



Facebook has not yet announced how much they will retain in the amount of money they call "fan support". But this is definitely a fat piece of cake that the social networking giant will not ignore. Previously, Facebook used to hold 30% of the revenue of game developers and currently, 45% of advertising revenue of those who allow ads to run on videos is also in their hands.

Facebook launched a new money-making method to keep streamer engaged with Facebook's platforms, linking fans on platforms like Facebook, Instagram and Oculus. And this is also a tool to help streamer make money.
