Dark Mode is now a function available in the Settings section of the Messenger application displayed by a switch button and can be turned on and off arbitrarily, whether or not the user has enabled this feature before.

To activate Dark Mode on Messenger, users need to click on the profile picture to access the installation item and click on the dark mode switch button.

When activating dark mode on Messenger, the light background and other elements will be replaced with a black background, the brightness is removed, which helps users reduce eye strain when used.
