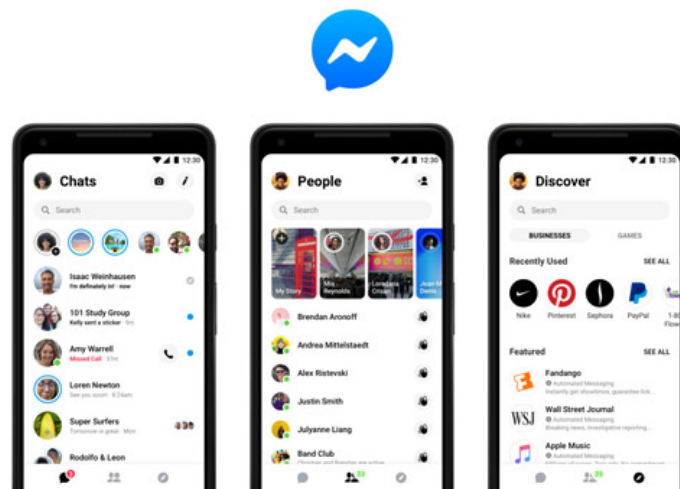


# Facebook Messenger will only allow forwarding of messages to up to 5 people
