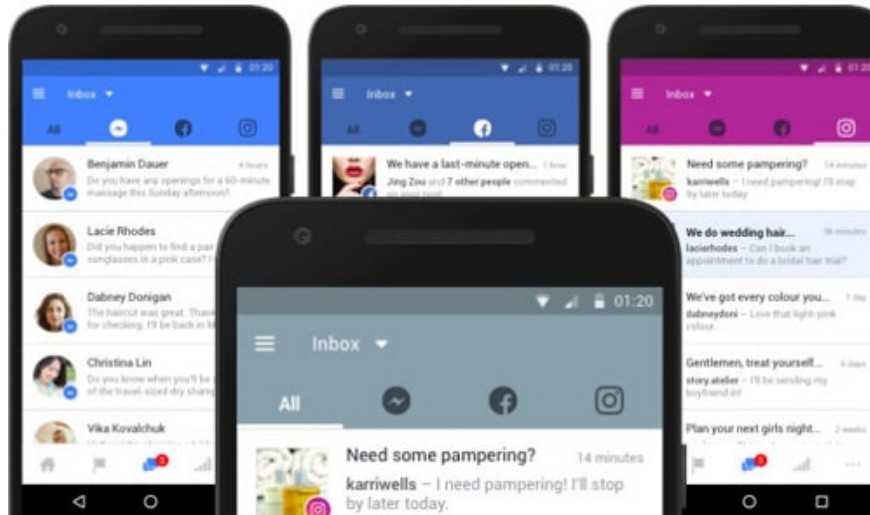


Facebook Pages, Messenger, and Instagram will have a shared inbox.

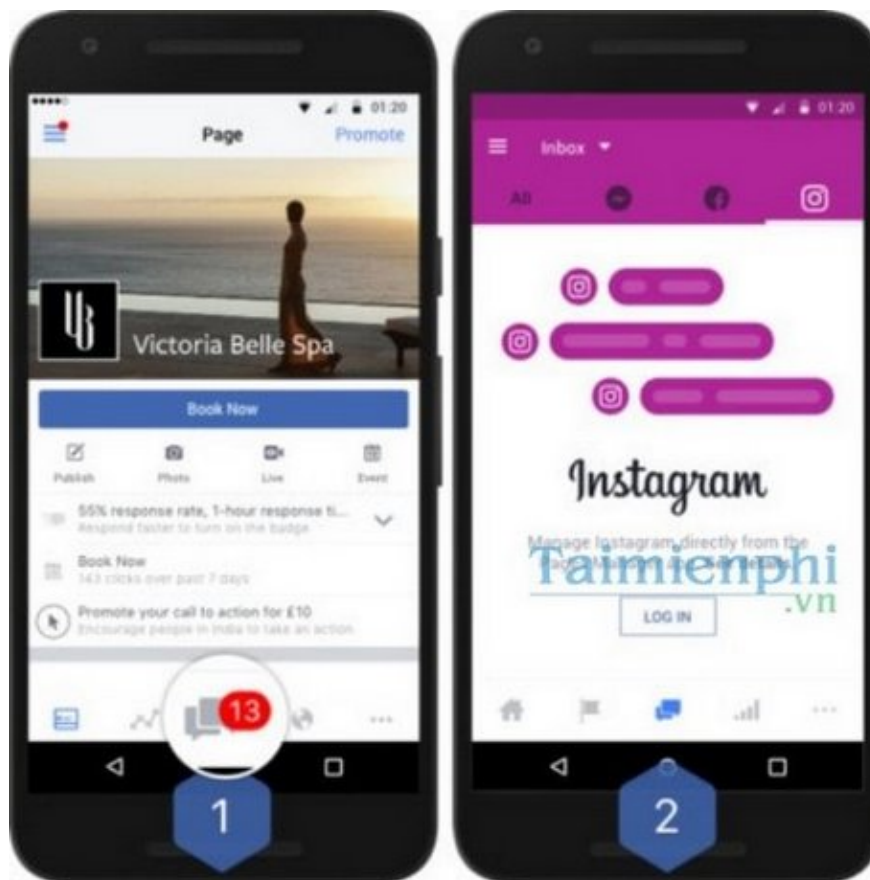
To access the shared inbox, you need to install the application.

Download Pages Manager for Android devices: **Facebook Pages Manager for Android**

Open Pages Manager and tap the message icon in the bottom menu bar of the app.

In the Inbox, you'll find tabs with icons for Messenger, Facebook, and Instagram. Tap each tab to view messages sent to you in those apps. For Instagram, you'll need to log in to your account to access the app's inbox.



In addition to messages, the Facebook tab will also include comments, guest posts, and page reviews. The app also displays basic personal information of those who message you and your page.

For users who are doing business on Facebook or building their brand through this channel, the shared inbox feature will be extremely useful. The feature will be updated on the Pages Manager app for Android and iOS. Versions for other devices will be added in the near future.
