According to an article by Ciaran Quilty, deputy director of Facebook's small businesses for Europe, the Middle East, and Africa, said the company will expand investment in artificial intelligence technology in France by hiring techniques. new professor and expand his scholarship program.



The announcement came a year after Facebook faced growing skepticism and difficult questions from regulatory agencies across Europe worried that social networking had become too strong. strong and leave many consequences.

In addition, Facebook said it would spend \$ 12.25 million through France's AI research center to boost the country's scholarship program. The number of doctoral students in the Facebook Research AI program will increase from 10 to 40 people. This amount will also be used to support 10 servers hosting open data sets for public agencies. And Facebook also plans to double the AI ??research team in Paris from 30 to 60 teams.
