However, Wong said that separate Messenger applications will still be retained exclusively for certain users.

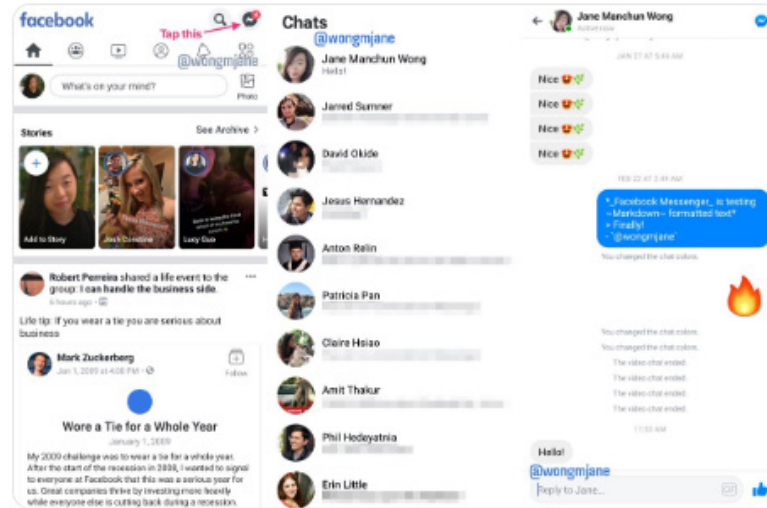
