

Fake IP for Android: 17 Best VPN Apps for Android Phones

To access blocked websites or geographically restricted internet services, you can use a virtual private network (VPN) to fake your IP address on Android; this remains the best and simplest option for most Android users.

A VPN runs as an app on your device. It hides your identity and allows you to access restricted content. TipsMake.com has compiled a list of the best VPNs for spoofing your IP address on Android, allowing you to access blocked websites on Android. Please check them out.

1. Fake Android IP with Secure VPN

1. Download Secure VPN

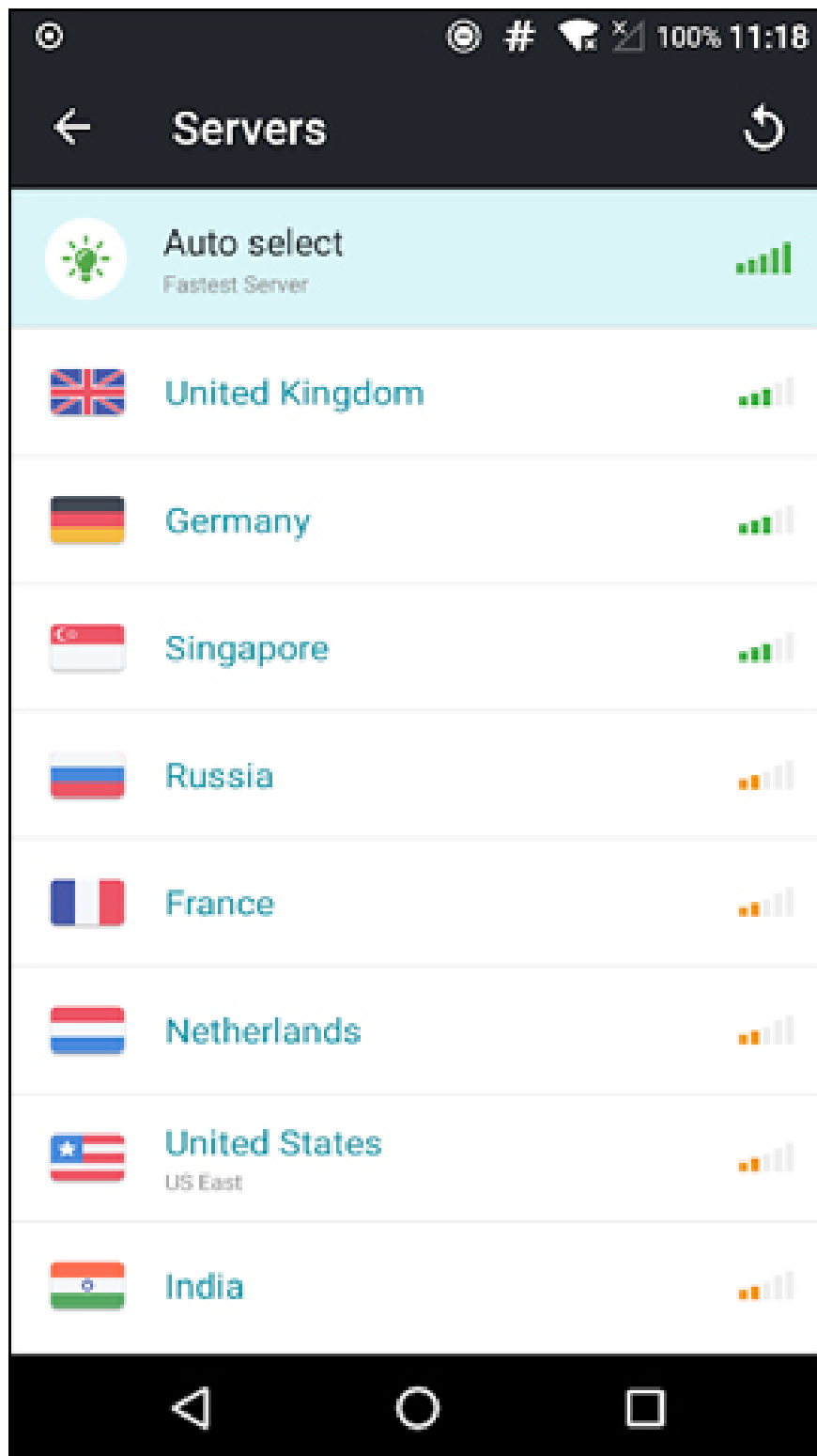
SecureVPN is a US-based VPN provider that stands out from other options in many ways. Secure VPN is a lightning-fast app that offers free VPN service. No configuration is required; with just a click of a button, you can access the internet securely and anonymously.

VPNs encrypt internet connections so that third parties cannot track users' online activity, making them safer than regular proxies and ensuring internet security, especially when using free public Wi-Fi.



CONNECTED





SecureVPN offers apps for Windows, iOS, Android, and Mac. OpenVPN support suggests that you can also set it up with other software and devices.

Installing the free Windows app is easy, and using it is straightforward: Choose your location in Germany, Italy, the United Kingdom, or the United States, click **Connect** to secure, and click it again when finished.

The Secure VPN Android app looks more modern, but the free version still only has 4 locations, requires no installation, has a 1GB monthly data limit, and also includes ads. (The Windows app may be basic but is ad-free).

SecureVPN claims it allows you to 'browse everything you need' 'without any restrictions'. The SecureVPN app offers the option to add up to 4 additional devices to the plan.

2. VPN Master fake IP for Android

1. Download VPN Master

When you have important and classified data on your PC, it's essential to have a reliable virtual private network running on your device. VPN Master is a security program created by the Capa VPN Group. With VPN Master, you can access geographically restricted websites as well as bypass restricted websites and apps using WiFi, 4G, and 3G.



This includes geographically restricted websites, government-censored websites, and websites blocked in offices and/or schools. VPN Master will hide your IP address and geographic location, and encrypt your internet traffic in both private and public spaces. It requires no root access, setup, or configuration. VPN Master uses a toggle switch to start running and provides standard features and performance. Similar to other VPN providers, VPN Master allows you to access all types of websites.

From here, you will be connected to the nearest server. You can also choose the server or node you want. Furthermore, you can use this VPN with WiFi or mobile data. This VPN software gives you access to websites worldwide. In any case, VPN Master does not publicly disclose how the application can achieve this.

VPN Master is a simple virtual private network (VPN) provider that allows you to connect to the server closest to you. VPN Master hides your IP address from websites; however, it's unclear what kind of encryption it uses. Compared to other mobile VPN providers, VPN Master needs to be more transparent with its users.

3. How to fake your IP address on Android using Touch VPN

1. Download Touch VPN



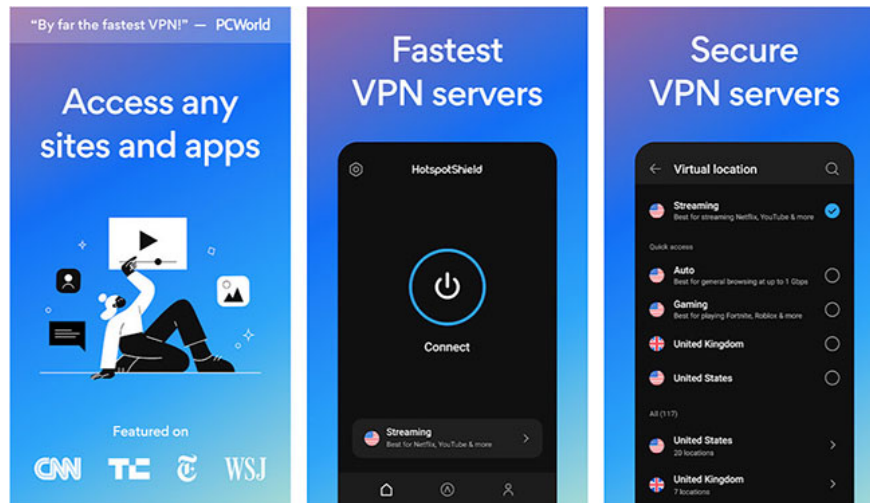
Touch VPN is a new face in the VPN market, and what makes it particularly interesting is that you can use this VPN without paying a single cent. On its website, Touch VPN promises to 'protect your data from hackers' and that you can 'browse anonymously'.

Touch VPN is compatible with Windows, Mac, iOS, Android, Edge, Chrome, and Firefox. You can use this VPN on as many devices as you like without bandwidth limitations. If you want to use Touch VPN on Android, iPhone, iPad, or iPod Touch, you can easily download and install the app with just a few clicks, using the convenient links on the website. Downloading the Chrome browser extension is equally easy.

Like most other VPN apps, Touch VPN comes with a list of locations, a Connect button, and a short menu. You can choose one of its protocols. Additionally, you can enable Split Tunneling, which allows some of your traffic to go through Touch VPN, while other traffic connects directly to the internet.

The Chrome extension has relatively few locations, including the United States, the United Kingdom, Canada, France, the Netherlands, Germany, and Russia. After you tap **Connect**, a new screen will appear with options to block trackers, ads, cookies, malware, and WebRTC leaks. You can also have Touch VPN automatically connect whenever you visit specific websites, and you can also specify which other websites will be accessed via your regular connection.

4. Hotspot Shield VPN Proxy changes your phone's IP address.



A virtual private network, or VPN, protects your web traffic from the prying eyes of your ISP, making it harder for spies and advertisers to track you online. Hotspot Shield VPN has a beautiful app and a range of security services that go beyond the protection of a typical VPN. It also boasts an impressive collection of servers globally, giving you plenty of options to fake your location.

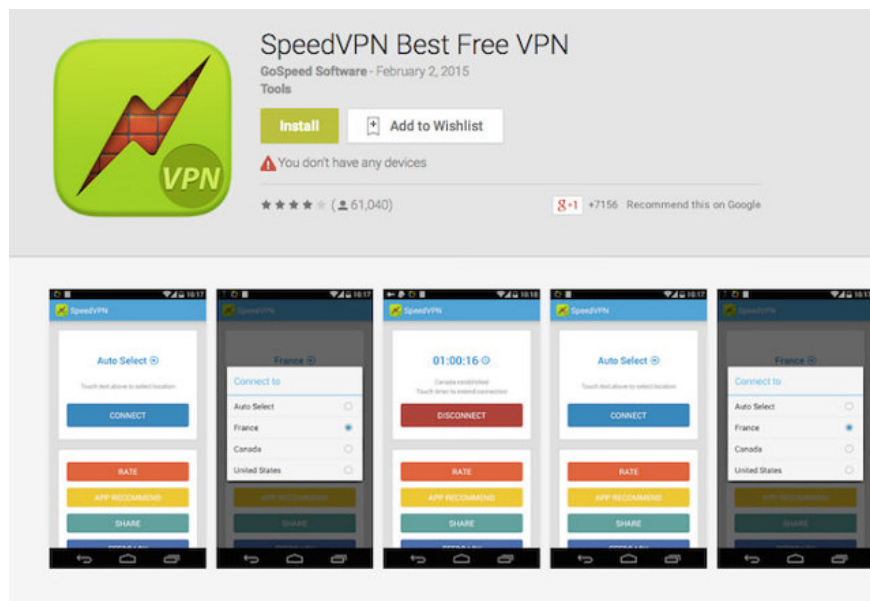
Hotspot Shield is one of the few VPN services that offers customizable free subscriptions. However, this option comes with limitations. Hotspot Shield's free Basic subscription limits you to only US VPN servers, one simultaneous connection, and 500MB of bandwidth per day. This is quite generous compared to TunnelBear's free version, which limits users to 500MB per month.

Hotspot Shield allows you to use P2P file sharing and BitTorrent on its network. It also includes Split-Tunneling, which lets you specify which traffic goes through the tunnel and what can't – handy for streaming video or for banks that frequently block VPN traffic.

Hotspot Shield does not provide access to the Tor anonymity network. Hotspot Shield also does not include multihop connections that route your traffic through a second server for enhanced security.

5. Speed ??VPN fakes your phone's IP address.

1. Download Speed ??VPN



GoSpeed Software's SpeedVPN offers a one-click VPN connection on your Android phone. This globally popular proxy app boasts fast servers and helps protect your privacy by preventing tracking. With its user-friendly interface, it's ideal for those seeking minimal protection and a solution to most internet censorship issues.

SpeedVPN is ideal for using geographically restricted websites like Netflix, Dramafever, CrunchyRoll, and Hulu on your phone. The app features the ability to toggle connections and allows users to choose from five IP address locations. Servers located in France, Canada, and the United States allow access to locations such as Germany, the UK, and Singapore. No root access is required; the proxy client speeds up your browsing under a VPN connection.

One connection provides users with 180 minutes of usage, and users can connect to the same connection as many times as they like. Users can also click once to extend the connection time by an additional 60 minutes, and can extend it as many times as they wish. The application provides sufficient bandwidth for light data usage and offers double encryption to protect your data.

Proxy is only available for download on the Google Play Store for Android devices. It can be downloaded for free without requiring payment details or registration. This app is compatible with most devices running Android 4.0.3 and above and takes up minimal storage space on your phone.

6. CyberGhost VPN fakes IP address.

1. Download CyberGhost VPN

CyberGhost is one of the best VPN services on the market today. Crucial to any quality VPN, it professionally protects users' online privacy with industry-standard encryption and offers a variety of specialized servers to deliver efficient performance when torrenting and streaming. CyberGhost also offers a 45-day money-back guarantee, significantly longer than the standard 1-month guarantee offered by other providers.

CyberGhost is a reliable and secure VPN for both beginners and advanced VPN users. It offers useful features, excellent encryption, good speeds, and even dedicated servers for better performance. However, some features, such as the ad blocker, don't work properly, and there are still some concerns regarding its logging policy and app permissions.

CyberGhost features advanced encryption, automatic kill switches, and an independently audited no-logging policy. CyberGhost also boasts a large server base – 11,500 servers in 100 countries. However, many of these servers are virtual, which can lead to slower performance compared to physical servers. This VPN offers many useful features, including dedicated servers and automation features for automatic connection and split tunneling.

ExpressVPN is a great example for those who want a wide selection of servers and high-speed results, with extensive global coverage and robust privacy protections to safeguard your information. The app also includes many additional features, such as an ad blocker and an adult content blocker.

ExpressVPN does not offer a free VPN subscription option. This is not surprising, as truly free VPN subscriptions are rare. The company accepts payments via all credit cards, PayPal, and other services like WebMoney. It is also possible to purchase an ExpressVPN subscription using Bitcoin.

ExpressVPN subscribers also get access to the company's password manager, Keys. There's also a new Threat Manager feature, which claims to block malware and trackers on users' computers.

ExpressVPN offers malware blocking capabilities within the VPN. Some VPN companies, such as NordVPN and CyberGhost VPN, have expanded to include other branded products like x and secure online storage. ExpressVPN, however, focuses solely on creating the best VPN possible rather than adding too many extra features.

ExpressVPN offers Split Tunneling, which allows you to specify which traffic will pass through the VPN's encrypted connection and which will pass outside of that connection. Split Tunneling is useful for activities like gaming or streaming, which require a lot of bandwidth but have relatively low risk. It also provides a kill switch, called Network Lock.

8. Download the NordVPN app to fake your IP address.

NordVPN is registered in Panama and its VPN service has over one million users. With over five million app downloads, NordVPN is also a popular choice.

Among its many interesting features, Double VPN technology stands out the most. This technology adds an extra layer of security by routing the user's connection through two separate VPN servers. With a no-logging policy, users can be completely confident that none of their activity is being tracked.

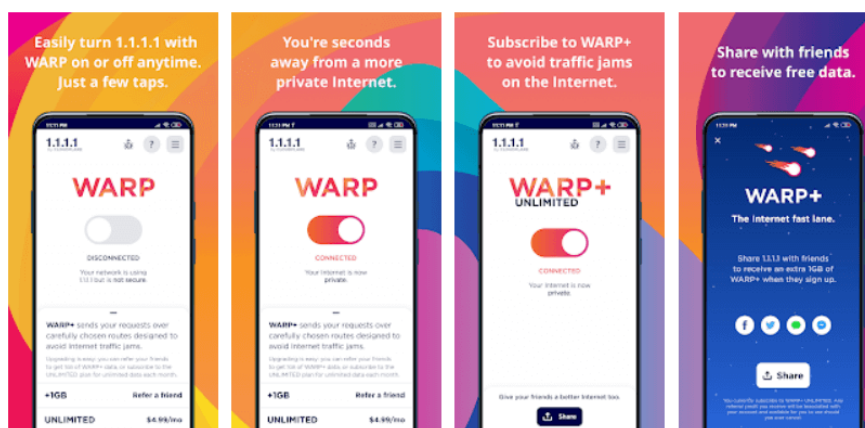
Take your cybersecurity protection to the next level with NordVPN's Threat Protection feature. You don't need to connect to a VPN server for it to work. Once you enable it in your settings, Threat Protection will keep your web browsing safe, fast, and smooth without tracking your online activity. Don't worry about downloading malware, dealing with intrusive trackers and ads, or accessing a malicious URL – Threat Protection will neutralize these cyber threats before they can cause any real damage to your device or data.

This is a good VPN service that provides you with a secure, encrypted tunnel for your online traffic. No one can see through the tunnel, get your online data, or find your real IP address and location. NordVPN is the best VPN if you're looking for peace of mind when using public Wi-Fi. Securely access personal information or work files, encrypt your internet connection, and keep your browsing history and online identity private. Enjoy online privacy and security with NordVPN.

NordVPN has an app for Windows, macOS, iOS, Android, Linux, and even Android TV. There are also encrypted proxy extensions for Google Chrome, Firefox, and Edge. The app may lack configuration options, but it's generally simple and easy to use.

9. Download 1.1.1.1

1. Download the 1.1.1.1 app.



VPN Warp+ 1.1.1.1 is developed by Cloudflare. TipsMake.com has a very detailed article about 1.1.1.1, which you can refer to. The strengths of 1.1.1.1 are that it's free, offers fast connections, provides anonymity, and allows you to access geographically restricted websites.

10. TunnelBear VPN

1. Download TunnelBear

TunnelBear doesn't have the largest network, the most apps, or the longest feature list, but it does a great job of simplifying VPNs for novice users. Additionally, WireGuard's support has nearly doubled speeds on Windows compared to other providers, and its annual testing is among the most thorough in the industry. TunnelBear isn't for experts, but it's well worth a try for VPN newcomers.



TunnelBear's free account only offers 2GB of data per month. While an improvement over previous versions, it's still only enough for occasional use. However, this option doesn't limit the number of locations you can use, unlike most free competitors. This is ideal if you're looking for a simple way to test the app before buying.

TunnelBear's monthly plan gives you unlimited data at a reasonable price of \$9.99/month. The price drops to a more affordable \$4.99/month for an annual plan or \$3.33 if you sign up for 3 years. These are competitive prices that beat many providers.



The logging policy is clearly described, and TunnelBear explains that it does not collect IP addresses accessing their website, IP addresses when connecting to the service, DNS queries when connected, or any information about the applications, services, or websites that users use when connecting to the service. Therefore, the company states that it cannot link any of its users to an action performed by a specific IP address.

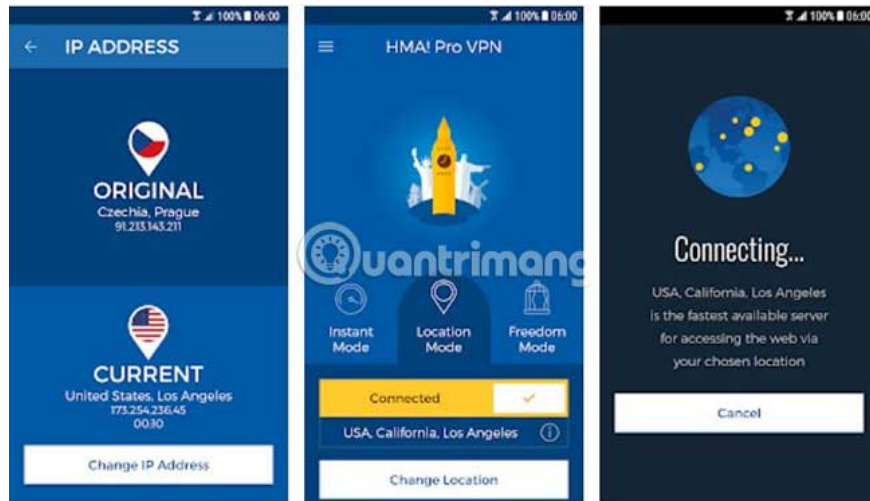
This service only records 'operational data,' updating this data as you connect. This includes your device's operating system version, the TunnelBear app version, whether you've been active this month, and the bandwidth you've used. Therefore, TunnelBear isn't exactly completely log-free, but it logs far less than other providers, and there's nothing here that could link you to any online activity.

11. Fake your Android IP address with HideMyAss!

1. Download HideMyAss!

HMA (or HideMyAss) is a relatively inexpensive VPN that claims to offer more server locations than any other service. Launched in 2009, HMA VPN is part of the Avast RSO cybersecurity product line. Despite past controversies, HMA has proven itself to be a reliable service.

HMA is most notable for its unprecedented server network, covering every country in the world. It makes IP addresses available to every region through a combination of physical and virtual servers.



HMA updated its policy to 'no logging' in September 2019, meaning it does not record any identifying data that could be used to retrieve a user's online activity.

This logging policy was verified by the reputable cybersecurity consulting firm VerSprite following an audit of HMA's systems in August 2020. The only personal information HideMyAss retains is email addresses and usernames, which is standard practice for VPNs.

Despite previous incidents involving the handing over users' connection logs to law enforcement, HMA has taken the necessary steps to become a trustworthy VPN service.

Overall, this is a good VPN. While it has many strengths, there are also some areas where it performs less effectively.

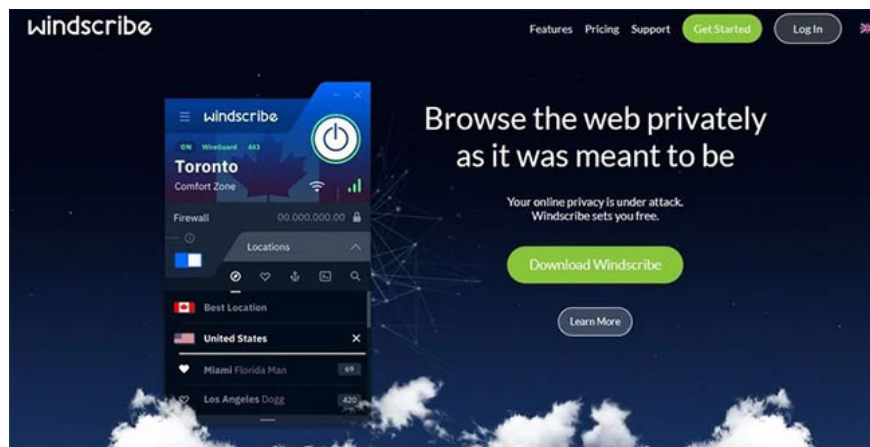


One thing many users don't really like is the fact that HideMyAss! is under UK jurisdiction and its speeds aren't as good as some other VPN options. For example, HideMyAss!'s Finnish servers experience an 8% drop in download speeds, while NordVPN's Finnish servers only experience a 2% drop.

Therefore, HideMyAss! is a great option that combines the advantages of an easy-to-use Android app and affordable pricing options.

12. Windscribe VPN

1. Download Windscribe VPN for Android



Windscribe VPN is a popular VPN that offers both free and paid plans to help users connect to the internet more securely. It provides users with the ability to connect with any number of devices.

Windscribe VPN is a virtual private network that protects your identity and reduces the chances of being tracked while you use the internet. It offers free and paid VPN services as apps and browser extensions. Windscribe VPN features allow you to spoof your global positioning system (GPS) to a country of your choice so you can access the internet without surveillance or restrictions.

Windscribe also blocks ads and offensive content, and protects your device from malware and phishing websites. It also has specific features that allow for optimal download and upload speeds while protecting you from attacks.

Like other VPN providers, Windscribe offers online privacy and security, while also granting users access to geographically restricted content. However, Windscribe VPN stands out for features such as static IP addresses and a dedicated kill switch, to control your online visibility and keep you safe while bypassing strict restrictions that other VPNs cannot.

13. Hide.me VPN

1. Download Hide.me



Hide.me is a Malaysian VPN that has been around since 2012. The app is free to download and use on all Android devices. Hide.me uses 256-bit encryption for user data and has a strict no-logging policy.

Hide.me supports multiple protocols including WireGuard, OpenVPN, IKEv2, SoftEther, and SSTP, features DNS, IP, and even IPv6 leak protection, and port forwarding is available if needed. The service can be used on Windows, macOS, Android, iOS, Linux, routers, consoles, and smart TVs. You can connect up to 10 devices simultaneously, and there's 24/7 live chat support if you encounter any problems. Hide.me also claims P2P support on most servers.

With a free Hide.me account, you get 10GB of free data every month. Plus, the Hide.me Android app comes with Stealth Guard, which lets you choose which apps can access the internet when the VPN isn't connected.

The app is user-friendly and lightweight, measuring just over 60MB when installed. The free version of Hide.me allows users to unlock geographically restricted content on streaming sites like YouTube and Spotify.

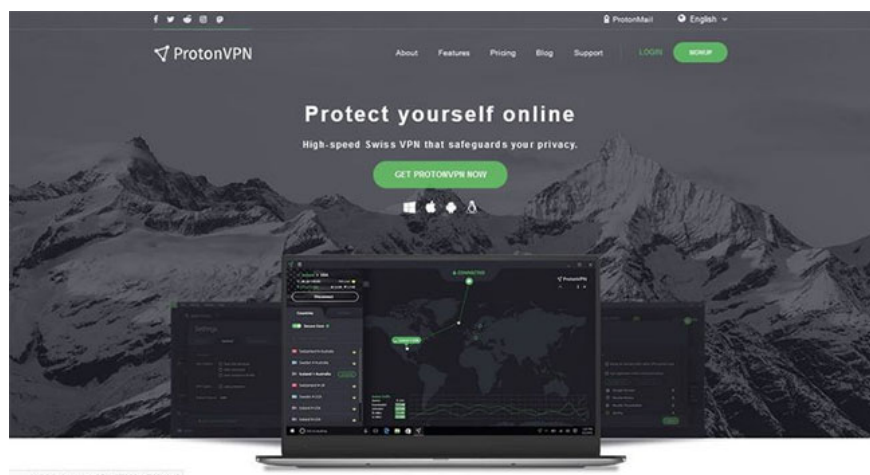
Disadvantages of Hide.me

A free Hide.me account does not unlock Netflix content. Additionally, you are limited to accessing only 5 of Hide.me's 75 locations.

You can only have one active connection per free account. So, even if you've installed it on multiple Android devices, you still can't connect them all at once.

14. ProtonVPN

1. Download ProtonVPN



ProtonVPN is a relatively new Swiss VPN service, launched in mid-2017. This VPN offers a free version along with a regular subscription-based model.

This secure VPN sends internet traffic through an encrypted VPN tunnel, so your passwords and confidential data are always safe, even over public or untrusted internet connections. ProtonVPN keeps your browsing history private, does not log user activity, or share data with third parties. ProtonVPN's anonymous VPN service allows you to use the internet without supervision. ProtonVPN breaks down internet censorship barriers, allowing you to access any website or content you want.

A free ProtonVPN account comes with 256-bit encryption, an optional kill switch, and DNS leak protection. The biggest advantage of ProtonVPN is that free users get unlimited data and can unblock geographically restricted

content on YouTube, Spotify, and even Netflix.

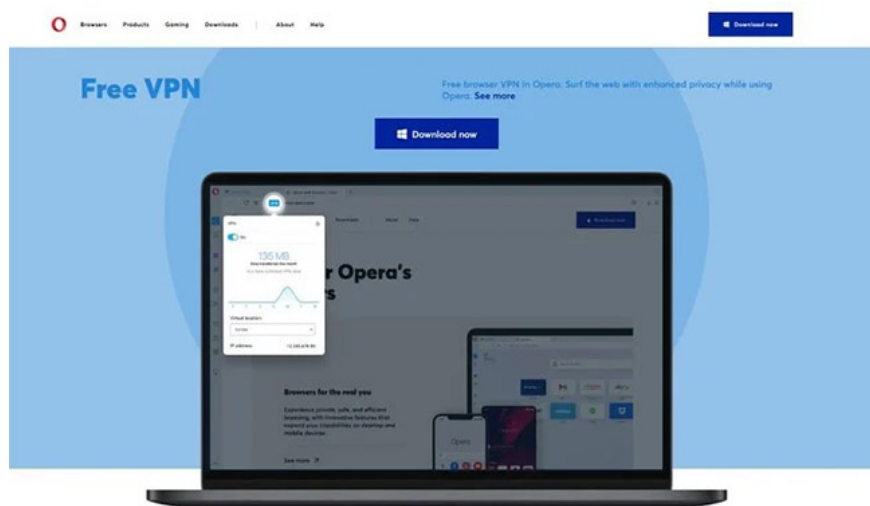
This Android app is only available on devices running Android 6.0 or later, but you don't have to worry about running out of space because it's super lightweight, has a beautiful dark theme design, and connects to the web securely and easily.

Disadvantages of ProtonVPN

The connection speed of the free account is too slow to comfortably stream videos and games at all times. Additionally, you only have access to ProtonVPN servers in the United States, Japan, and the Netherlands.

15. Opera VPN

1. Download Opera VPN



Opera VPN is slightly different from all the other free VPNs on this list. It doesn't have its own app but is a feature embedded within the Opera web browser. Opera VPN is 100% free and has no paid version.

Opera VPN encrypts all data you send and receive through the browser. It has a no-logging policy, and you benefit from unlimited data. Browsing with a virtual IP address hides your location and allows you to view the web with greater privacy. Opera's free VPN ensures your internet traffic within the Opera browser is secure. No need to download any additional apps or browser extensions.

The Android app is a bit large, around 130MB when installed. But you can consider it a two-in-one solution since Opera is also a powerful web browser. The VPN part of the Android browser doesn't offer much customization, but it's very easy and fast to use.

Disadvantages of Opera VPN

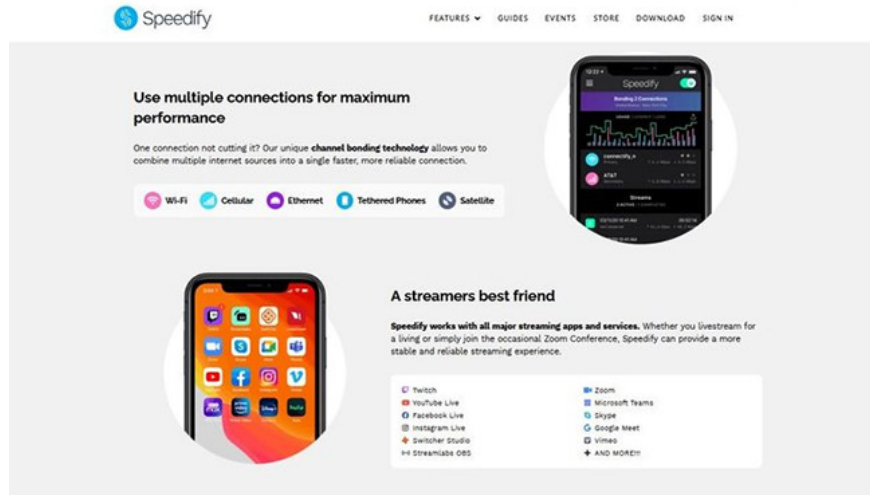
Opera VPN does not unlock any geographically restricted content on YouTube, Netflix, or Spotify. Additionally, Opera only has four dedicated VPN servers based in the US, Germany, Canada, the Netherlands, and Singapore.

The connection speed isn't optimal for streaming, but with a little patience, you can still watch videos online on YouTube and other streaming platforms.

And note that because it's built-in, Opera VPN doesn't encrypt data traffic from other apps on your phone.

16. Speedify

1. Download Speedify



Speedify is a US-based software that offers both free and paid versions. This VPN collects some basic user data but does not keep activity logs. Speedify also uses 128GCM encryption for your data.

You get 2GB of free data that renews monthly with a free account. Speedify works with all major streaming apps and services. Whether you stream daily or simply join occasional Zoom meetings, Speedify can provide a stable and reliable streaming experience.

Speedify is the ultimate connection tool for streamers. It automatically prioritizes audio and video streams, then adjusts to network conditions to start streaming at the right speed for all connections!

With Speedify, you can unlock US versions of Netflix, Hulu, and Spotify and access geographically restricted content. You also get access to all servers in over 33 locations.

Speedify is by far the lightest app on this list, taking up approximately 15MB when installed. The app is very simple, and you can enable your VPN in less than 5 seconds.

Disadvantages of Speedify

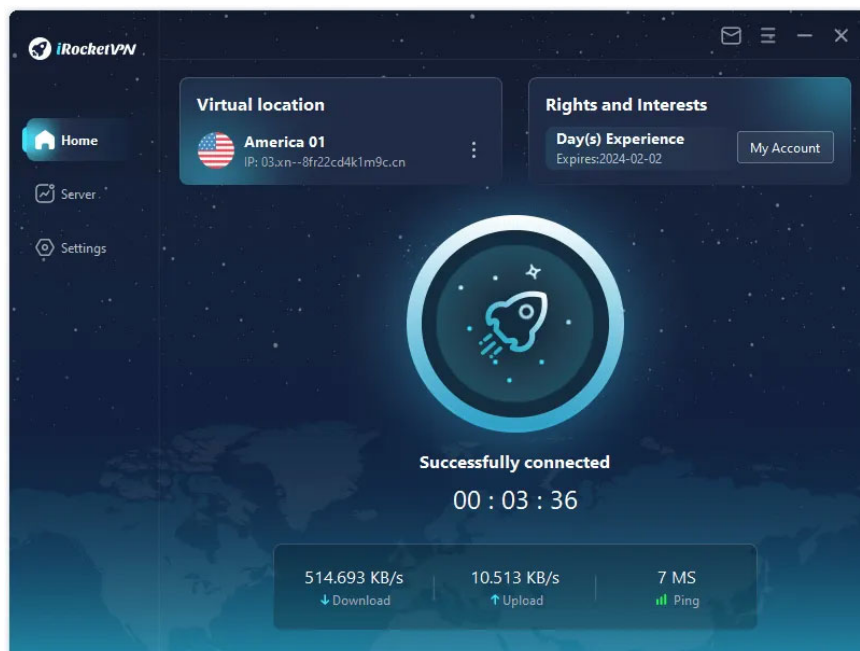
The downside of Speedify is its connection speed. It tends to slow down connections for free users. For Netflix, you can only access the US version using Speedify, which isn't very useful if you already live in the US.

17. iRocketVPN

1. Download iRocketVPN

By using iRocketVPN, you can browse the internet with peace of mind, knowing your online activity is safer and more private. Whether you're traveling and need to access geographically restricted content or simply want to keep your online activity private from prying eyes, iRocketVPN can help. With servers located around the

1. No logging policy - Like ISPs, VPNs can store user activity logs. It's advisable to choose a VPN service that adheres to a strict no-logging policy.
2. Strong encryption - There is an industry standard for AES 256-bit encryption. This is the standard you should look for in a VPN.
3. Android support - You must ensure that the VPN you are considering supports and will work smoothly on Android devices.

Above is a list of VPN apps for Android that you can use to change your phone's IP address. These apps are all free, require no login or complicated steps to connect, and allow you to quickly access blocked websites.
