

# Fastest Ways to Move in Minecraft 1.19

Fastest ways to move in Minecraft 1.19, Fastest ways to move long distances in Minecraft 1.19, save players time

Minecraft is a huge open world and players will spend a lot of time moving around in the game. Because storage space is limited, inexperienced players may have to spend time moving back and forth between bases and gathering resources. To save time and effort, let's learn the fastest ways to travel long distances in Minecraft 1.19.

## Ride a horse



This is probably the easiest method that gamers can implement immediately in the early stages of the game. Horses can be found in plains and savanna biomes and tamed by mounting them until they produce heart particles. However, the player needs to get the saddle from the chests in the village to control the horse.

## Riding donkeys, mules and llamas

Donkeys are similar to horses, however, they move more slowly to be able to carry more items. 15 additional item slots allow players to gather more resources to transfer to their base. The player can breed a donkey with a horse to create a mule that retains the ability to carry but has a higher speed.



Llamas are useless for moving from place to place, but they can carry a lot of items in chests. If the player wants to gather a lot of resources for the structures, a caravan of camels can definitely solve this problem.

## Fly by Elytra

Elytra Wings are a premium item that only spawns in End Ships, so they can be found hovering over End City. Those cities are located outside the End Islands, 1000 blocks away. The players can access the islands through the End Gate, which is only accessible after defeating the Ender Dragon.



Elytra's ability to fly is dependent on its durability, as it loses one point per second while dashing. An Elytra spacer has an endurance of 432, which is equivalent to 7 minutes and 12 seconds of surfing. This helps the game move to a distance of about 10,000 blocks.

## Minecraft

Minecart and rails are probably one of the best systems to use if a player wants to connect his bases. They transport players and entities without any input, however, the player first needs to create a rail system to the location.



To create a long rail system is quite expensive, the player needs 6 iron ingots and 1 stick to have 16 rails. If you want to have enough materials, building an iron golem farm is a must.

Electric rails are even more expensive because they require gold bars instead of iron. In addition, the player also needs to add a piece of redstone dust. They are best for use on railway tracks as the powered rails are capable of increasing the speed of a moving Minecart.

## Boats and runways

Skating on the ice paths by boat is really one of the fastest methods of moving in Minecraft. When boats are on any variant of the ice block, they can be maneuvered as easily as if they were in water and can travel at tremendous speeds thanks to the slippery nature of the ice.



The speed of the boat can be changed based on the ice variant the player uses. Normal ice is the slowest, followed by packed ice, and bluestone is the fastest option.

## Nether Gate

Nether portals are actually an easy method to teleport between bases. Whenever a player walks about 1 block in the Nether, they will walk about 8 blocks in the Overworld in the same direction.



This means that the combination of the Nether portal with any other mode of transport can allow players to travel between bases in the Overworld in just 1/8 of the time.

The disadvantage of this method is that it is quite expensive. Players need a lot of resources to create various portals and connect them together.

## Soul Sand + Soul Speed ??Shoes

Soul Sand is a special block in the Nether that slows the player's movement speed. However, if they have a boot with Soul Speed ??this debuff will be reversed. Players can move 61.5% faster on Soul Sand with Soul Speed ?? III (compared to normal ground movement).



Therefore, to do this, the player just needs to build a 1-block wide path from point A to point B using Soul Sand or Soil and simply sprint on it with a speed increase of 60%.
