

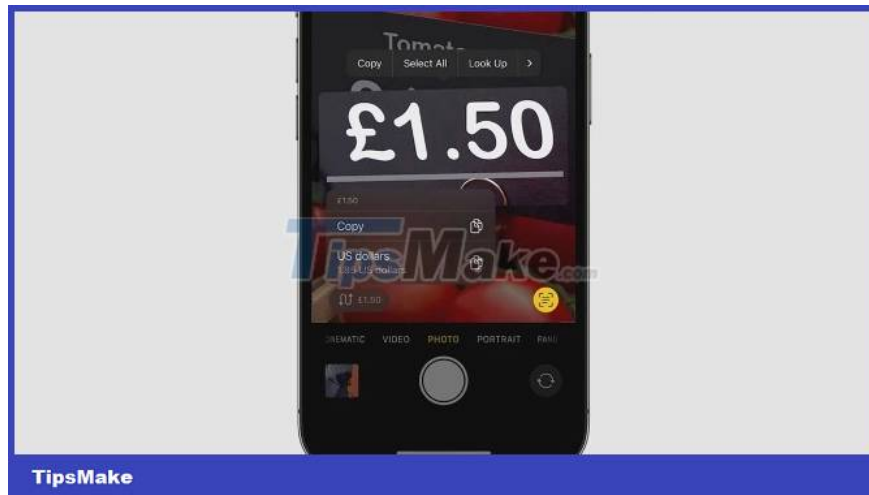
Features on iOS 16 that do not support older iPhones

iOS 16 was introduced by Apple at the event in early June. The new version of Apple's mobile operating system has many new features, but many features only support new iPhone models.

In this article, TipsMake.com will list the features on iOS 16 that do not support older iPhones.

Features that only support iPhone XS and above

iOS 16 has many features that only support iPhone models using A12 Bionic chip or higher including iPhone XR, XS, XS Max, 11, 11 Pro, 11 Pro Max, SE 2020, 12 mini, 12, 12 Pro, 12 Pro Max, 13 mini, 13, 13 Pro, 13 Pro Max and SE 2022. Therefore, the features below will not support iPhone X, iPhone 8 and iPhone 8 Plus.



Upgrades for Live Text

On iOS 16, Live Text is improved to support both videos instead of just supporting photos as before. However, this new improvement will only support iPhone models from iPhone XS and above. Older iPhone models are not supported.

Voice text input upgrade

Voice text input (Dictation) on iOS 16 is equipped with a new interface. In addition, it can also manually add punctuation, insert emoticons (emoji) into the text. These upgrades also apply to Siri but not yet Vietnamese.

Scan drug labels with camera

With iOS 16, users can access the Health application and then use the camera to scan the drug label and add dosage, set a reminder to take the medicine .

Search images in the app

The iOS 16 Spotlight search feature can scan images in Messages, Notes, and Files to find places, people, or objects that appear in the photo.



Press and hold to separate the subject from the background

This is a pretty cool feature of iOS 16, it allows you to easily separate objects from photos to share in messaging applications, storage, take notes .

Astronomy Wallpaper

Astronomy wallpaper is one of the new wallpaper options in iOS 16. Due to the complex nature of the technology, this wallpaper will only support iPhone XS and above.

Features only for iPhone 11 and above

Live Caption is a new feature on iOS 16 only for iPhone 11 and above. It allows users to display live subtitles on the content that is playing, applicable to both videos and FaceTime calls.

Features exclusive to iPhone 13 and above

Finally, iOS 16 has some features exclusive to the iPhone 13 series:

Open Face ID when turning the device horizontally

A notable update of iOS 16 is to enable the ability to open Face ID when the iPhone is rotated horizontally. However, so far this feature only supports iPhone 13 and above, it is unclear if Apple will extend support to older iPhones.



Blur the foreground in portrait mode

In portrait mode, iPhone 13 users can blur the foreground (in front of the subject) to create a more realistic depth of field effect. This feature even supports both 1x and 3x zoom levels.

Improved portrait video quality

In cinematic mode on the iPhone 13 and iPhone 13 Pro, the depth of field effect is better demonstrated with slant angles around small details.
