

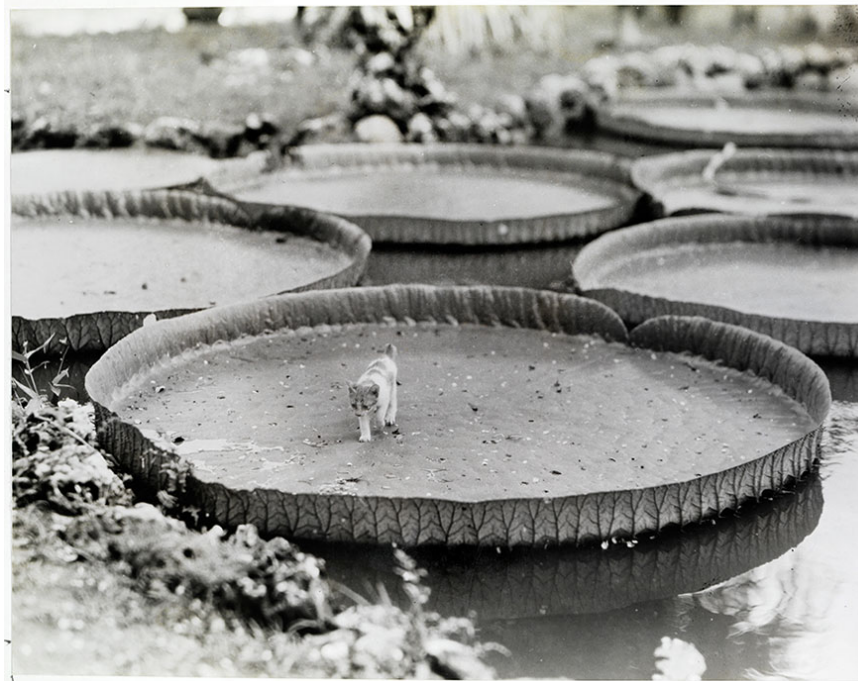
Feel the beauty of life from 25 unpublished photos of National Geographic

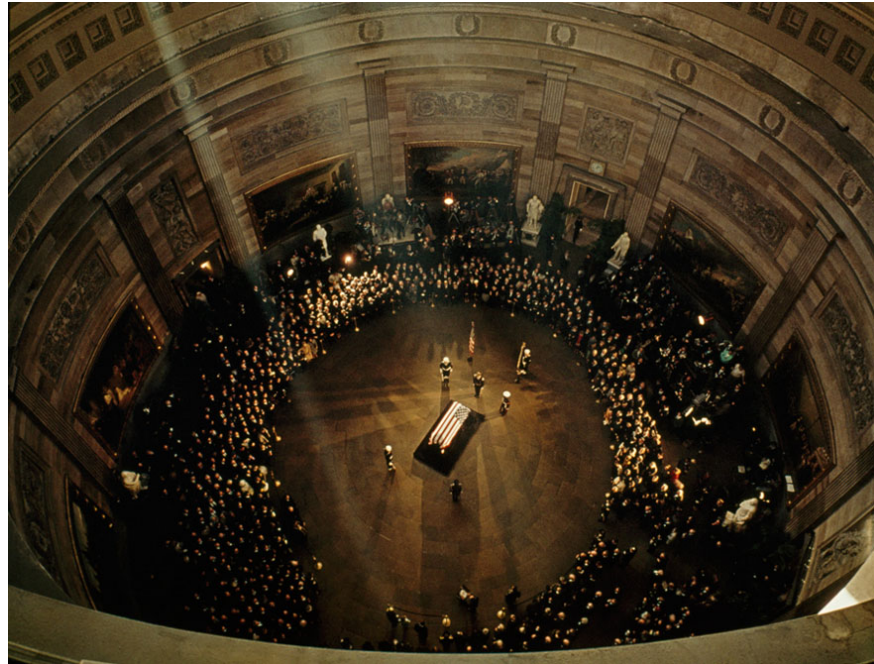

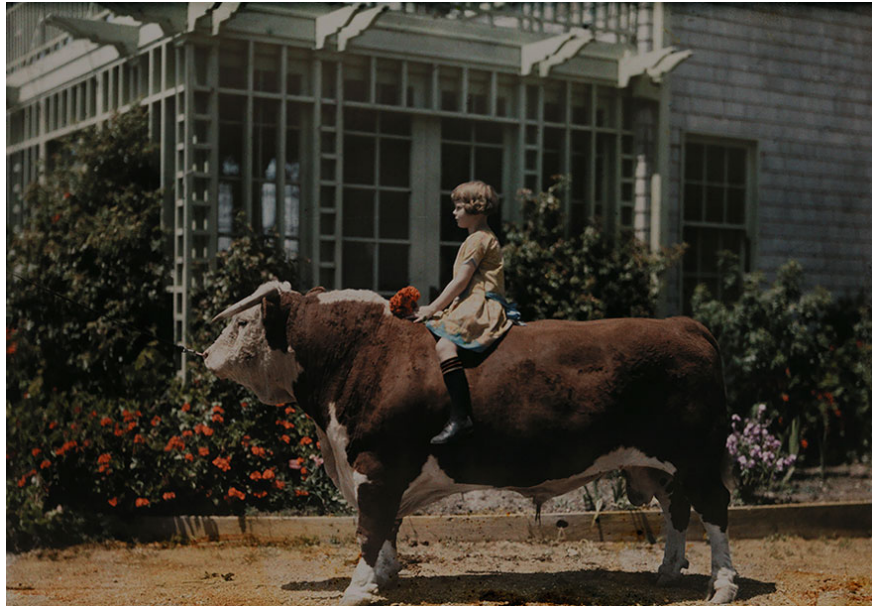
