## Some common terms used in LOL

- **FF**: Surrender.
- **Noob / Newbie** : Refers to new players with poor skills.
- **AD / ADC** : Gunner - the main dame of the team. Normal people go to the bottom.
- **AP / APC / Mid** : Magician. The main cause of the team dame.
- **Tanker / Top : Top laners** . Usually, champions have good stamina. Surf the team.

- **SP (Support)** : Players support the team. Usually paired with AD.
- **Jungler** : The **jungler** of the team.
- **Gank** : Supporting pedestrians. Usually the mission of the player to the forest.
- **AFK (Away from keyboard)** : Refers to someone not controlling the character. Maybe it's because they're having a busy busy or losing their life .



- **Cover** : Baoji, support teammates. Usually applied to players in the tanker position (top lane) or support (support)
- **CC (Crowd Control)** : General limiting skills such as slowing, stunning, fear, knocking .
- **MVP** : The best player in the match. Usually the one with the nice KDA, contributing most to the team's victory.
- **KDA** : Kill - Dead - Assits. The higher the number indicates that the player had a very good match.
- **GGWP (Good game well play)** : Usually used at the end of every match. A good match.
- **Troll** : Only action of a certain player intentionally breaking the game, helping the opposing team, not cooperating with teammates.
- **First Blood** : the act of gaining the first life in the match.
- **ACE** : the act of wiping out the opponent.
- **Go to the board to count the numbers** : Only the actions you have just been defeated and are waiting for the character to revive.
- **Care** : Dangerous.
- **Slow** : slow down the enemy.
- **Stun** : stunning the enemy.

- **Bait** : lure the enemy.
- **Combo** : A series of skills and tactics.



- **Dis** : is Disconnect - lost Internet connection.
- **Push** : Go push the tower.
- **EZ** : means Easy. Indicate match marks easily
- **Exp** : Experience points.
- **Feed** : Some player dies too much.
- **Last Hit** : kill soldiers (creeps) to get gold.
- **Nerf** : Decreased power.
- **Roam** : Turning the road, supporting other roads. Nearly similar to Gank.
- **Snowball** : Promote the advantages that we have
- **Onions** : Refers to the player who is constantly losing.
- **KS** : The only one who was robbed to take his life is about to die.
- **Farm** : An action to destroy soldiers to get money and experience.
- **Ulti** : The strongest skill of a character.
