FIFA Club World Cup tournament format

The tournament has two distinct format eras.

2005-2023 Era (7 teams)

1. Number of teams: 7 teams, including 6 continental champions and the host country's champion.
2. Format: Knockout. The European and South American champions are automatically qualified for the semi-finals, a recognition of the superiority of these two footballing nations.

New Era from 2025 (32 teams)

1. Number of teams: Increased to 32 of the world's top clubs.
2. Frequency: Every 4 years.
3. Format: Similar to the World Cup for national teams. 32 teams are divided into 8 groups (4 teams each), playing a round-robin. The top two teams will advance to the round of 16 and compete in a knockout match until the final.



Competition venue

Previously, the tournament was often held in countries with potential such as Japan, UAE, Morocco and Qatar. Hosting brings great prestige and tourism promotion opportunities for the host country.



The 32-team tournament will be held in the United States in 2025. The specific stadiums have not yet been officially announced by FIFA. However, it is expected that the tournament will take advantage of modern, high-capacity stadiums of NFL and MLS teams across the country, similar to how the country prepares for the 2026 World Cup.

Cups and Prizes

The FIFA Club World Cup, also known as the "FIFA Club World Cup Trophy", was introduced in 2005. The trophy is made of silver and has an intricate design with six curved pillars representing the six continental confederations, supporting a globe simulating a soccer ball. Raising the trophy is a moment to affirm a club's position as the world's number one club.

1. Prize money is an important part of the appeal of the tournament.
2. Old format: The champion team received about \$5 million, and the runner-up team received \$4 million.

New format (from 2025): The financial lure will skyrocket. Although official figures have not been released, reports suggest the total prize fund could reach €2.5 billion (around \$2.7 billion), with the winning team potentially receiving hundreds of millions of dollars. This is a huge financial incentive that could change the status of any club.



Famous players who have participated

The tournament is the stage for the biggest stars. Almost every living legend has been on the field:

1. **Cristiano Ronaldo:** Champion with Manchester United and Real Madrid.
2. **Lionel Messi:** Many times crowned with Barcelona.
3. **Toni Kroos:** The player who has won this tournament the most times in history (6 times).
4. **Sergio Ramos, Karim Benzema, Luka Modri?:** Real Madrid's pillars in an era of dominance.
5. **Wayne Rooney, Mohamed Salah, Robert Lewandowski:** Other big stars have also lifted the trophy.
