

# Find Snap Seed and Gourd Seed in Sekiro: Shadows Die Twice

This article will show you how to use Snap Seeds and Gourd Seed in Sekiro: Shadows Die Twice

In Sekiro: Shadows Die Twice, certainly not many players have been repeatedly defeated by Lady Butterfly, and once you know how to defeat Lady Butterfly, the battle with her is still extremely difficult. However, besides being defeated by pure skill and being seen as a form of blow.

However, in the confrontation with Lady Butterfly, there is also an item that will help you a lot in the confrontation with Lady Butterfly, which is Snap Seeds. These small items will help players to fly illusions, stun them, and stun certain enemies, making some battles easier.

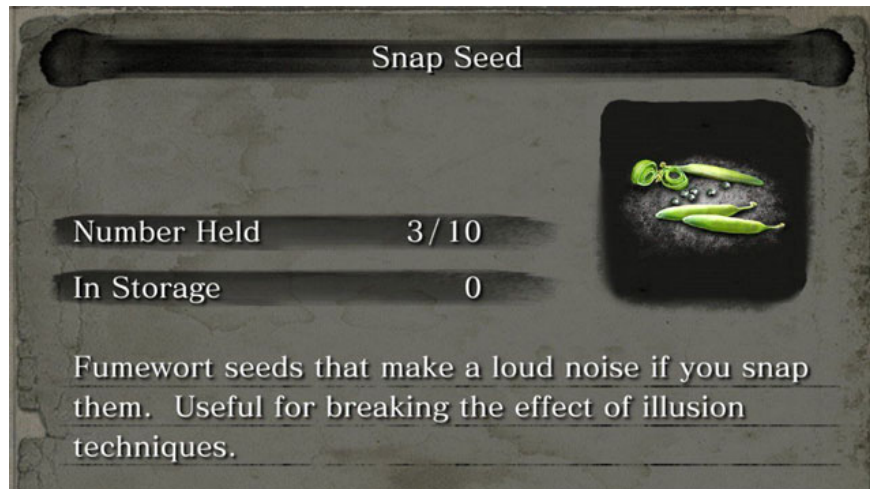

## Find Snap Seed and Gourd Seed in Sekiro: Shadows Die Twice

### 1. Find Snap Seeds

If you want to defeat Lady Butterfly quickly, you should find it first. Snap Seeds can be found in many locations. The easiest to find is the place where you have just overcome the giant snake. Once you reach the ice wall and crash into the snake, it will drop the Snap Seeds in the surrounding area for you to find.

If you want to get more than Snap Seeds, you can go to the village of Mibu to buy more. Some other Snap Seeds can be found in the **Gun Fort** area after the **Sunken Valley Passage Idol** , or you can find some more in the Bodhisattva Valley. After defeating **Tru Corrupted Monk** and unlocking **Dragon's Tally Board** , you will be able to purchase them from merchants in an unlimited number.



## How Snap Seeds works



Snap Seeds are mainly used for boss battles, or certain enemies at the end of the game. When used it will break the enemy's illusion creation skill. A best example is in the battle with **Lady Butterfly** . When she uses illusion in the second battle period.

You can use Snap Seeds to repel illusions and make battle easier, but can make players loophole when using it. Snap Seeds can also be used to defeat **Corrupted Monk** , causing him to be stunned 3 times before it is disabled. Mist enemies in **Hidden Forest** could also be repelled by Snap Seeds.



Besides Snap Seeds, we also have another very useful item in Sekiro: Shadows Die Twice is the Gourd Seeds. This item is used to heal the characters in the game, helping you escape from the more difficult encounters than using **Healing Gourd** to heal. There are all 9 Gourd Seeds scattered in the game, and you can find them through the "address" list below.

## Location of all Gourd Seeds in Sekiro: Shadows Die Twice

### 1. Naomori Kwarada



The first location of Gourd Seed you get is the killing of General Naomori Kwarada near the Outskirts Wall - Gate Path Shrine.

### 2. Chained Orge



The second position to receive the Gourd Seed is after you defeat the boss Chained Orge. Hook up the wall on the gate behind where it is chained and turn left, then go straight in and you will see Gourd Seed on the ground.

### 3. Kongo



The third seed is obtained when you cross the **Abandoned Dungeon** and first set foot on the Kongo Mountain area, then enter the temple and go down. You will see a room of monks praying before a cross-legged mummy. Gourd Seed is right in front of the mummy and hurry up and grab the Gourd Seed in front of him, noting that he can launch killer mobiles to attack you.

### 4. Ashina



The fourth Gourd Seed will be found when going to Ashina Castle. Climb the big staircase and along the way you will find a few shooting points up, climb and hook gradually to the roof of the big castle. There will be a few monsters around you that will bother you, go around behind to the left, you will see a window hook up to a secret room. Climb there and you'll see a treasure chest with a Seed Gourd inside.

## 5. Ashina Gate



Want to find the Fifth Gourd Seed, go from the gate of Ashina Castle to the battlefield where the General rides a horse there. Climb the big staircase in front of you and turn right, follow a path and turn left and go up the stairs. You will see a trader selling a Seed Gourd at a price of 1000 sen.

## 6. Dilapidated



The sixth seed is still at Ashina Castle. On the roof where the crows are hiding, a thief is hiding from the guards. Destroying all the ninja and guards, the thief will appear near Dilapidated temple and he sells a lot of things, including the Gourd Seed you are looking for.

## 7. Shrine Valley



The seventh Seed Gourd can be found after meeting Lord **Issihin** , when the player is sent to Sunken Valley. When you first reach this area via the Shake Shrine, there will be a statue right under Under-Shrine Valley and from here, jump down to the edge of the wall and go to the other side on the right.

You will see there are a few enemies in this area, you can ignore them and go into the short tunnel right there. Shoot the rope to swing over the two branches on the left, then on the left wall you will see some white streaks, climb up then go through the small tunnel, shoot the wire to the other side and climb to the right wall . Look right and down, you will see the Gourd Seed in the roof.

## 8. Mibu



After crossing Hidden Forest, you can go to the village of Mibu, and the village temple will have a river. Traveling along the river flow you will see a group of patriotic villagers, you can fight with them or skip and continue. You will see a fenced area with another group of enemies, keep going to a garden and you will see a tree with white flowers, run into the bottom of the tree will you see the 8th Gourd Seed below there.

## 9. Castle Grounds



The last seed you can find in the **Foundtainhead Palace** near the end of the game, the last Gourd Seed is quite easy to get. Begin by going from the Statue of Sculpture to the Castle Grounds, then go inside the building and turn right, go straight inside and you will see treasure chests. Open up and you will see the last Seed Gourd.

Through the user guide and the list of Gourd Seed appearances, it will make it difficult to fend off the bosses in **Sekiro: Shadows Die Twice** , but you need to keep in mind that healing will not work. Destroy bosses more easily.

That only becomes more convenient when you need to train more skills to control the character well and quickly hand to catch the trajectory of boss attacks.
