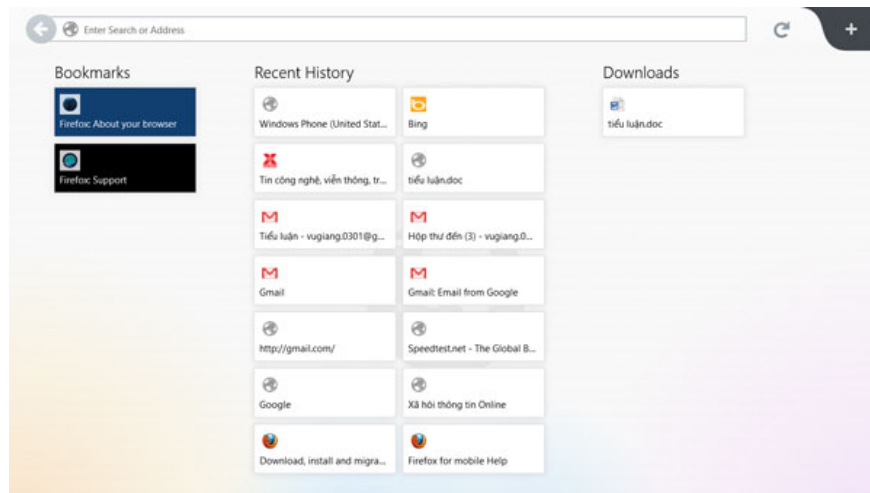

According to the Benchmark site test, the new version of Fox Fire is 20% faster than Firefox 17 and 7% versions compared to other browsers.

Firefox 18 improvements:

For desktop computers, Firefox beta has some minor improvements, such as providing a way to disable insecure content on site HTTPs, improving response time for proxy users, improving performance when switching tabs. In addition, this version also provides preliminary support for WebRTC - an open source software that helps users to make video chat conversations in real time.

The beta version on the desktop is also built to support basic touch features according to W3C standards - a common set of standards for website developers for today's popular browsers.

However, this new style version of Firefox for Windows 8 is only part of the development of Firefox versions, so according to Firefox in these versions may not include the MIA-style version. .

If you still want your application to be modern, you can click here and download the new version after "*firefox-20.0a1.en-US.win32.installer.exe*". But compared to the first MIA-style version, this version still has errors when you move the mouse, the mouse's movement speed will be very slow compared to normal.



For Android users, the new Firefox beta includes many search suggestions, but only appears for users to choose during the first browser launch. Firefox will also issue warnings when users are accessing websites that are suspected of containing malware, phishing attacks. It also provides some options for you to exit before downloading pages. that web.
