For Firefox 9 running on PC, the new **Type Inference** technology improves Java Script performance by up to 30%. In addition, standards like *HTML5*, *MathML* and *CSS* are better supported on this browser.

For Firefox running on Mac OS X Lion, the integration of the *browser* theme is also improved by the manufacturer. In addition, users can switch between different windows by surfing two fingers. Multi-point feature when the original web browsing is only available on Safari.
