

# First image of smartbook Lenovo runs Android

The smartbook is currently unknown as to what kind of waves the Google Android operating system version is applied to.

**The first images of the Lenovo smartbook have been posted by BTV Natasha Lomas, Silicon.com, on November 20.** Although it is just a prototype, this machine has very remarkable features such as Qualcomm Snapdragon processor chip, Google Android operating system, 8 hours of continuous battery, besides wireless connections. Similar to current smartphones such as 3G, Wifi, Bluetooth and some " *other connections* ".



The smartbook is currently unknown as to what kind of waves the Google Android version of the operating system will be used for. And according to a spokesman for Qualcomm's permanent vice president, this will be the first smartbook product and will be the first to apply the Google Android platform to devices from Lenovo.



It is aimed at reaching a wide range of customers, who are fed up with the long boot times of current laptops or netbooks (which is different from smartbook's fast boot times, equivalent to smartphone).



And there is a noticeable point, in the photo taken for Silicomn.com, there is also another smartbook, which is reportedly from Quanta manufacturer with features: keyboard and screen separator Removable, also works on Google Android, also uses Snapdragon chip.
