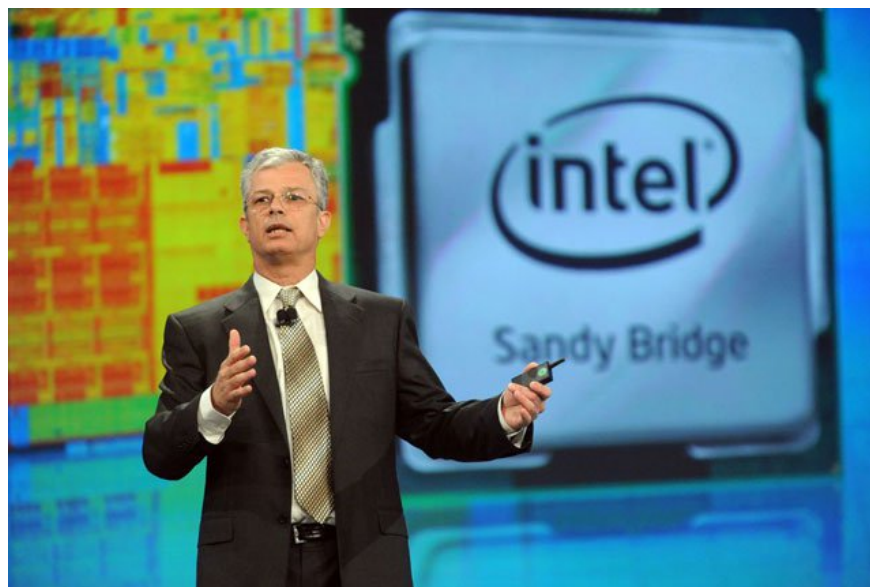


First laptop to use 'Sandy Bridge' chip

Laptoping site has just discovered a number of new laptop models using Intel Core processor second generation and **AMD Mobility Radeon HD 6550M** (generation of new AMD graphics cards). Models like Acer Aspire (code name **AS7741G6426**), **Gateway** and **Lenovo IdeaPad Y560P** all have Intel Core processor (quad-core) i7-2630QM.

According to *Laptoping* , Intel Core i7-2630QM chip is one of the first microprocessors of 32nm manufacturing technology chips using " **Sandy Bridge** " microarchitecture. This platform integrates technology and integrates new graphics processing capabilities for superior performance over the past.

The second generation Intel Core was first introduced by Intel on January 5 at this year's CES exhibition. It is expected that this type of processor will first appear in two versions: dual core (two cores) and quad core (4 cores).

Currently both Acer and Lenovo have not officially launched the computer models above. According to previous information, all manufacturers will launch computers using Intel processor " **Sandy Bridge** " platform early next year.
