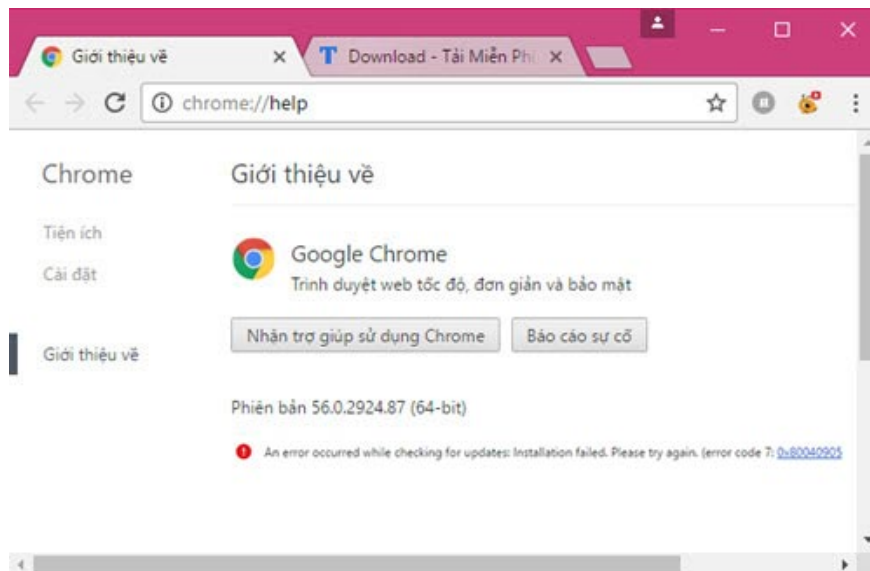


# Fix error code 7 0x80040905 when updating Google Chrome

Error code 7: 0x80040905 on Chrome is quite rare for users, but when it does occur, it often causes confusion and frustration. Therefore, if you update Google Chrome and encounter error code 7: 0x80040905, remember the troubleshooting steps provided in this article by TipsMake.

There are many ways to fix error code 7: 0x80040905 on Chrome, as it's not actually a difficult error to resolve. Furthermore, this issue isn't unique to Chrome; Firefox and CocCoc also experience it, despite having different names.

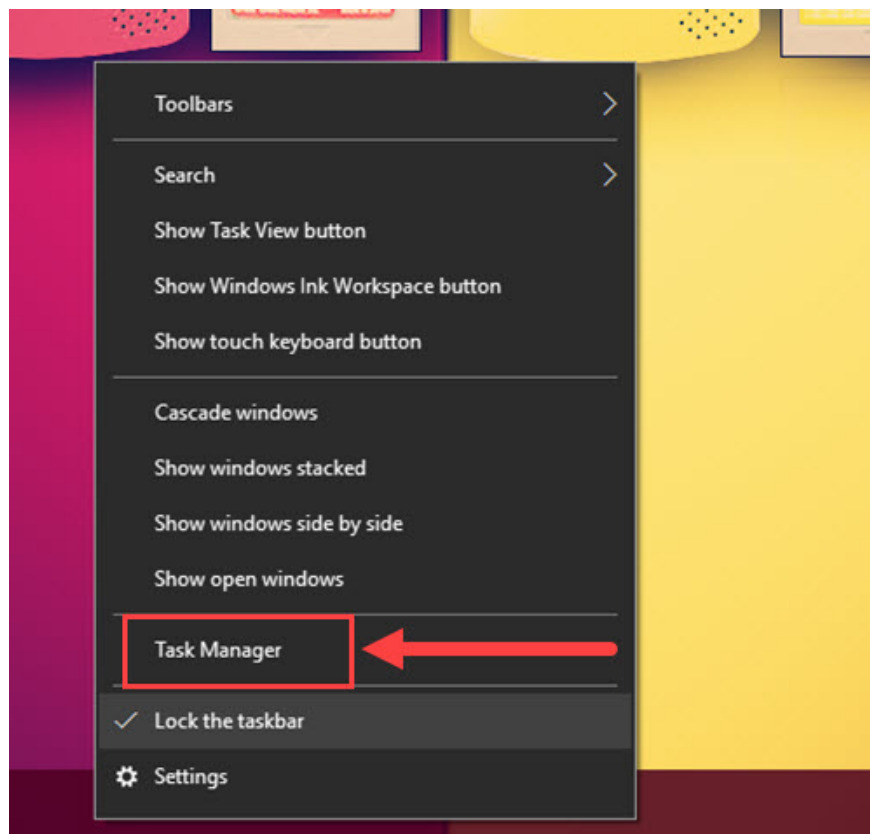


## Fix error code 7: 0x80040905 when updating Google Chrome

Error code 7: 0x80040905 on Chrome occurs during a version update process. For some reason, you are unable to upgrade, the Chrome upgrade process fails, and to fix error code 7: 0x80040905 on Chrome, do the following.

### Fix error code 7: 0x80040905 on Chrome.

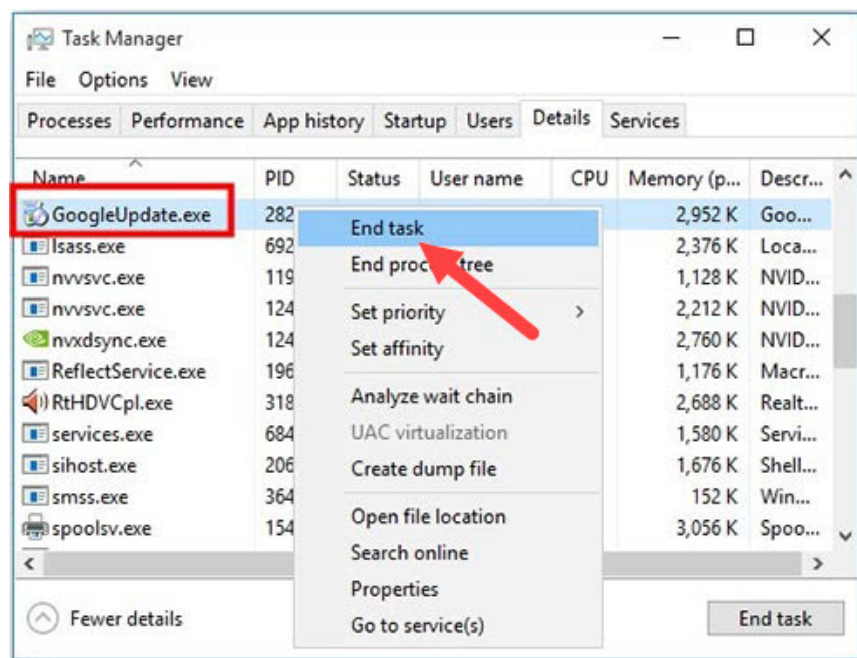
*Step 1:* To fix error code 7: 0x80040905 on Chrome, you must first open **Task Manager** by pressing **Ctrl + Shift + Esc** or right-clicking on the Taskbar and selecting Task Manager.



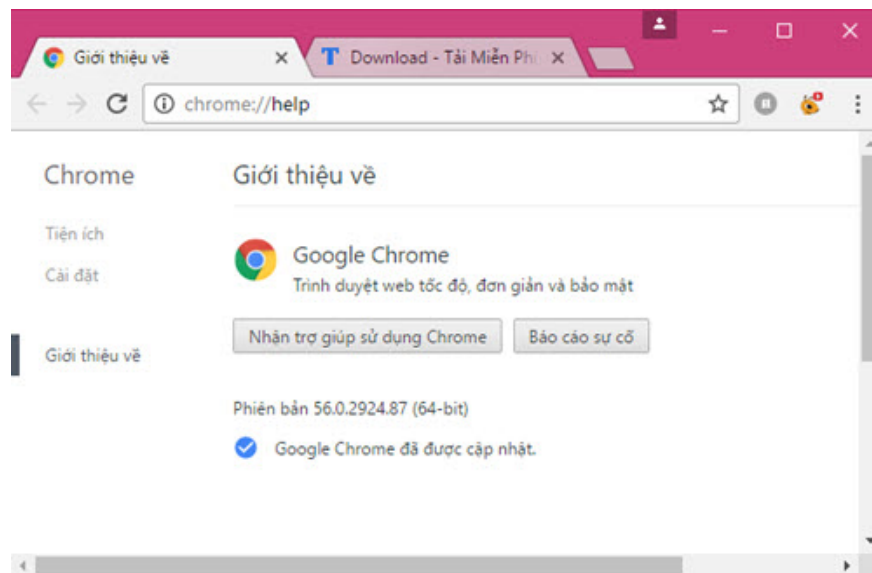
Step 2: Once Task Manager is open, select the **Details** tab and find the running **GoogleUpdate.exe** process.

- Then right-click on GoogleUpdate.exe and click **End Task** to close it.

- Similarly, find the processes named **GoogleUpdateOnDemand.exe** , **GoogleCrashHandler.exe** , and **GoogleCrashHandler.exe** and close them.



*Step 3:* After completing the above steps, restart Google Chrome, go back to **Help > About Google Chrome** to check if the fix for error code 7: 0x80040905 on Chrome is complete and if Chrome is updating normally.



If you have followed our instructions correctly but still cannot fix error code 7: 0x80040905 on Chrome, please uninstall Chrome and install the latest version of Google Chrome here: [Download Chrome](#) . TipsMake always updates to the latest version of Google Chrome, so you don't need to worry if you are unable to successfully fix error code 7: 0x80040905.

Above is our suggestion for you to effectively fix error code 7: 0x80040905. With this method, your update will no longer be hindered. The method TipsMake uses to fix error code 7: 0x80040905 has been tested in practice, so its accuracy and success rate are very high.
