

Fix errors that automatically turn on WiFi on Windows 10 Mobile

After upgrading your phone to Windows Mobile 10, the error automatically turns on WiFi. If the user does not notice, the battery will quickly exhaust, affecting the phone.

Some people after upgrading their phones to Windows 10 Mobile often see the status of the phone automatically turn on WiFi, although not used to access the network. This will cause the phone to run out of battery quickly, if the user does not pay attention to turn off WiFi. In fact, this is the default setting on the phone when Windows 10 Mobile is successfully updated and is also easily corrected according to the network administration instructions below.

- 1. If your phone doesn't upgrade, follow the tutorial. Here's how to update your phone to Windows 10 Mobile, whether it's supported or not!**

Step 1:

On the main interface screen, click to select WiFi to reset.



Step 2:

At the **WiFi networking** section turn on **Off** to make sure WiFi is not turned on.

Under the **Turn WiFi** section **back on** , if By setting, it will set In 1 hour mode to mean that WiFi will automatically turn on after 1 hour. To turn off this mode, touch the frame and select **Manually** mode.

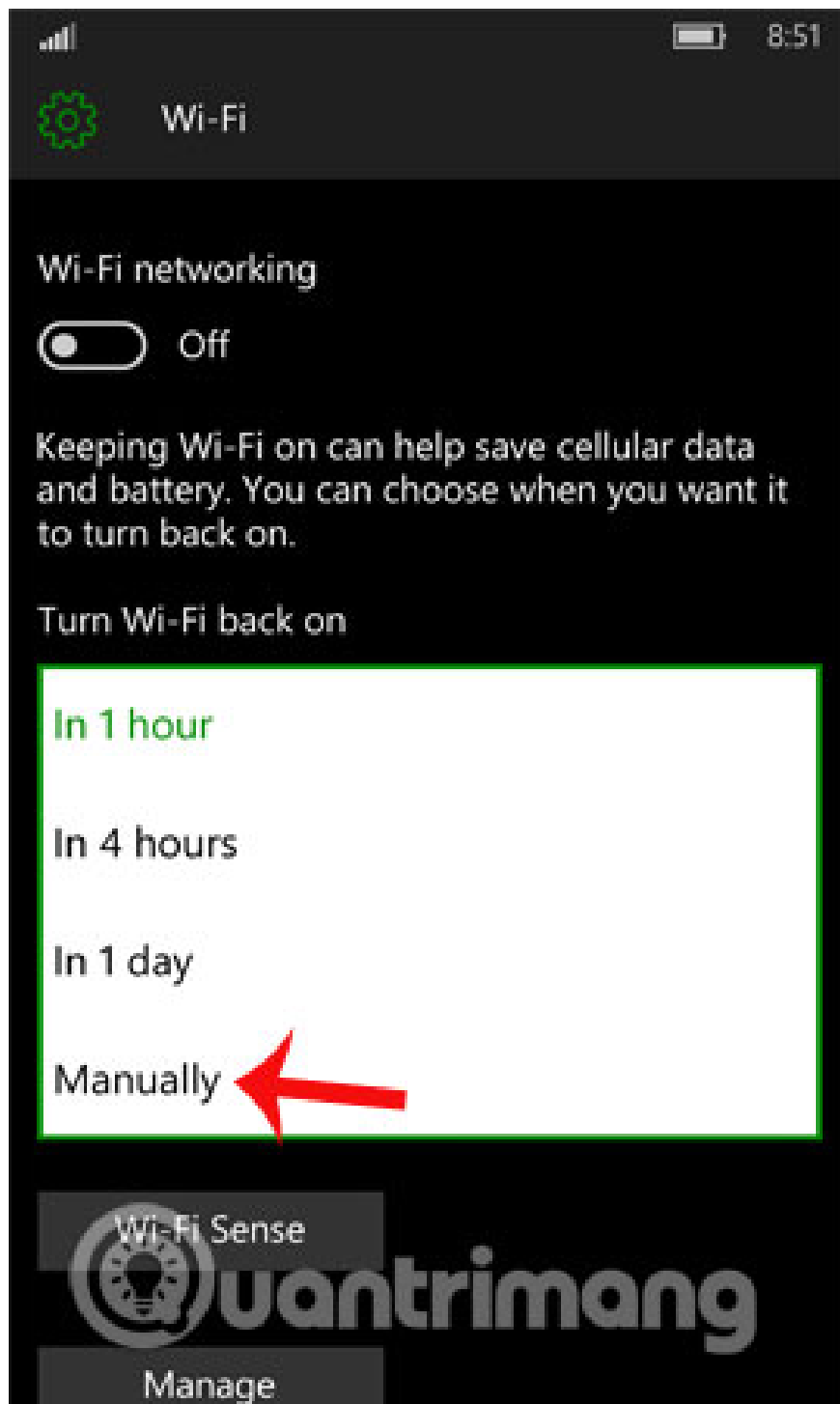
