## 1. The cause of iTunes 1671 error

Some of the causes of iTunes 1671 error may be due to:

1. The operating system version is too old.
2. The iTunes version is too old.
3. Antivirus software is not suitable.
4. There are many USB ports connected to the computer.

## 2. Some good tips

1. Make sure the iTunes version has been updated to the latest version.
2. The iTunes version must be compatible with your iOS device.
3. Connect your iOS device to a compatible USB port (USB 2.0 or higher).
4. Make sure your computer has the latest operating system version installed.
5. Check the security system on your computer. It is likely that you will have to update or uninstall software that causes the error.
6. Unplug unnecessary USB drives.
7. Change the USB cable.

## 3. Steps to fix iTunes 1671 error during updating iPhone and iPad

**Step 1 :**

**Disable** antivirus programs on your computer or Mac.

**Step 2 :**

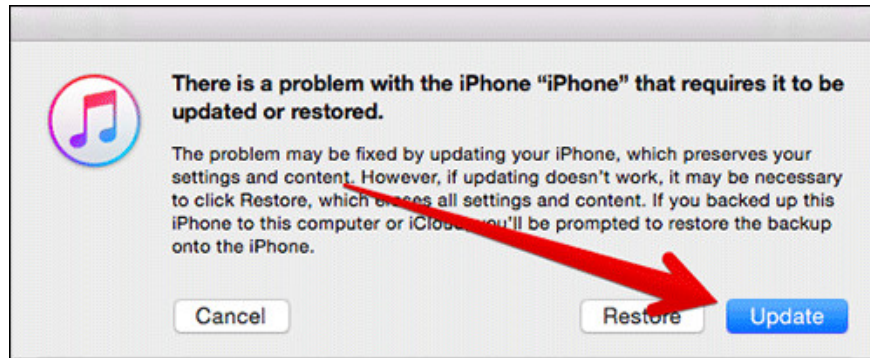
**Start your** iOS device.



Press and hold the on button, turn off the power for about 10 seconds.

### Step 3 :

Connect your iOS device to your computer with a **USB cable** , then open iTunes and try updating iTunes again.



## 4. Other solutions

### Step 1 :

Disable antivirus programs on your computer or Mac.

### Step 2 :

Next you need to find the Host file on the computer.

### Step 3 :

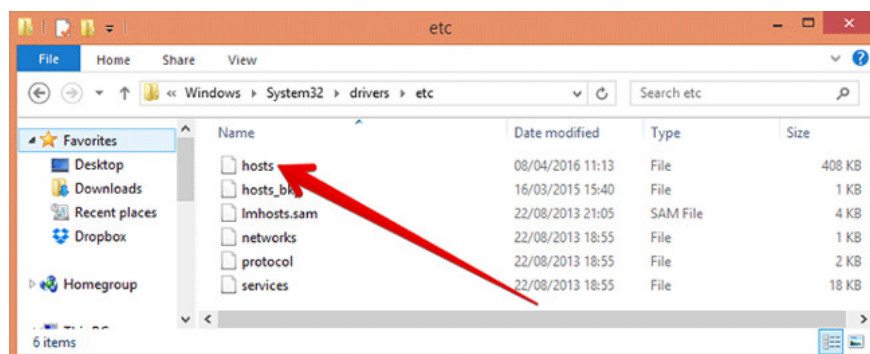
#### On a Windows computer:

On a Windows computer, visit **My Computer => Drive C: /.**

Next step, access by path:

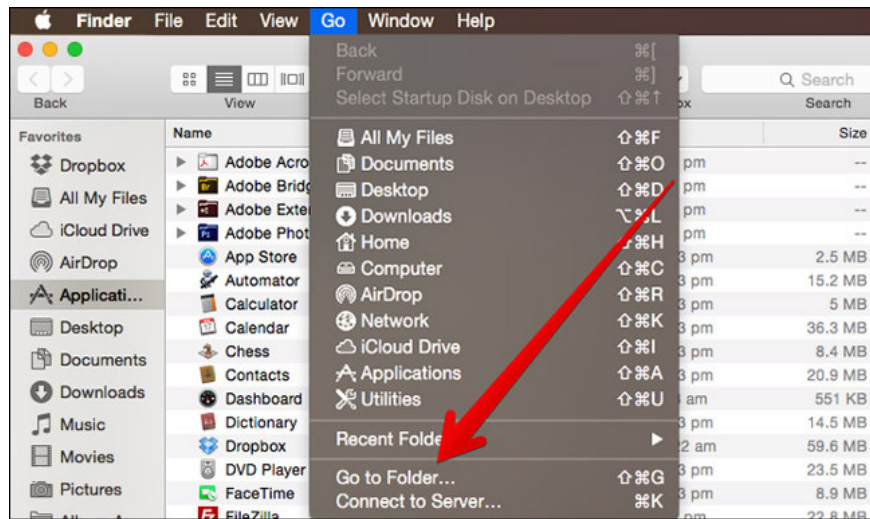
**Windows => System 32 => drivers => etc and search for Hosts file .**

Drag and drop Hosts file to Desktop screen.



#### On Mac:

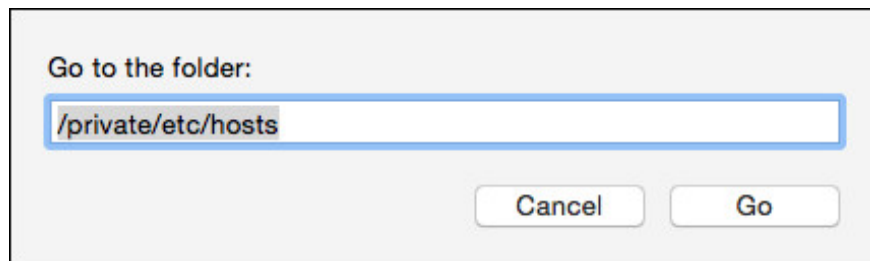
You will have to use the Finder to search the Hosts file, then drag and drop the Hosts file to the Desktop. On the Menu Finders bar, you access **Go => Go To Folder** .



**Step 4 :**

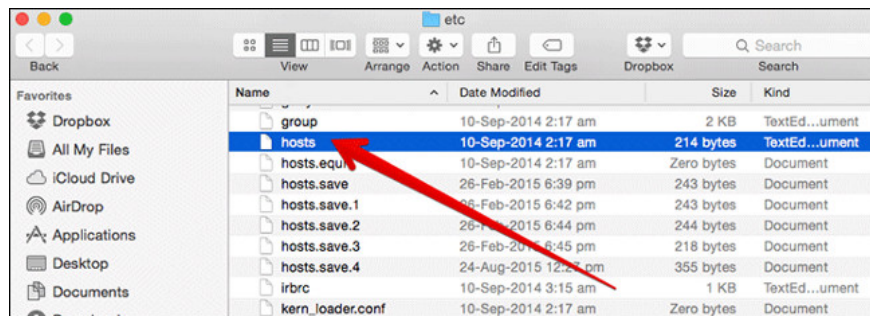
On the next frame, enter the location of the path below and press Enter:

`/private / etc / hosts`



**Step 5 :**

A **Finder** and file host window will appear on the screen here. Drag and drop the file to the **Desktop** screen.



**Step 6 :**

Mine iTunes on your computer and try restoring your device. After the process has finished, you can "bring" the host file back to the location in the directory.
