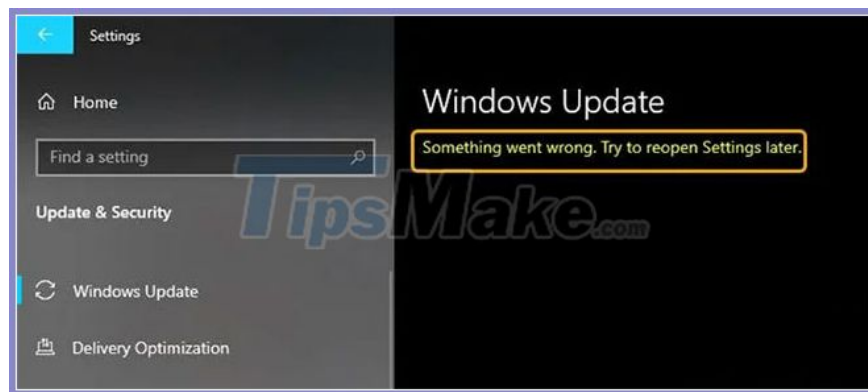


# Fix 'Something went wrong, Try to reopen Settings later' error on Windows 10

If when you try to access the Windows Update page through the Settings app to check for updates, you see a blank page with the message 'Something went wrong, Try to reopen Settings later', then this article will help. for you.

If you run into this problem, you can try the below suggested solutions in order and see if that helps resolve the issue.

Let's take a closer look at each of the solutions listed!



## 1. Reboot the Windows 10 device

You can try restarting your Windows 10 device. To restart the device, press Win + R keys to bring up the Run dialog box.

In the Run dialog box , type shutdown / r and press Enter.

At startup, if the problem persists, try the next solution.

## 2. Reset the Settings app

If the Windows 10 Settings app is not working properly, then you have a very effective way to solve this problem. Microsoft allows you to reset the Settings app.

## 3. Run an SFC scan

If there is a file system error, you may have this problem. In this case, you can run an SFC scan and see if that helps resolve the problem. If not, continue with the next solution.

## **4. Unblock Windows Update using a third-party utility**

This issue partly shows that the Windows Update page is blocked and inaccessible. In this case, you can download and run StopUpdates10 - a third-party utility.

Once downloaded and installed, just run StopUpdates10 and click the Restore Windows Update button , then wait for a confirmation message to appear saying Windows Update is not blocked.

Once confirmed, simply close the application and check Windows Update to see if it has been fixed and restored.

## **5. Perform the Reset This PC, Cloud Reset or Repair Windows 10 option**

At this point, if the problem is still not resolved, it is most likely because some kind of system error cannot be solved in the normal way. In this case, applicable solution here is you can try the Reset This PC or Cloud Reset option to reset all Windows components.

You can also repair Windows 10 using installation media as a last resort.
