

Fix STOP error 0x0000007b on Windows 7, XP, blue screen error

Error 0x0000007b, also known as blue screen of death error, is most common with Windows 7 and XP users. To fix error 0x0000007b on Windows 7 and XP, you need to check the cause of the error and find the most optimal solution in the following ways.

Fix error 0x0000007b on Windows 7, XP

1. Computer infected with Virus.

For computers that have been infected with viruses leading to error 0x0000007b, you need to fix it by downloading top anti-virus software to scan on your computer. It can be said that computer virus infection is the most common cause of error 0x0000007b on Windows.

2. Driver error.

Reason:

- The device driver that the computer boot controller needs to boot was not configured during the boot process.
- The device driver that the computer boot controller needs is corrupted.
- Information in the Windows XP registry is corrupted.

You can go to the homepage of the computer company you use to update to the new Driver version for your computer.



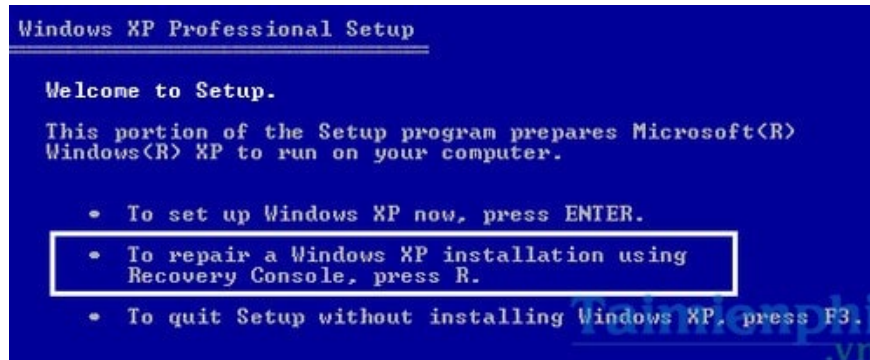
You can also download some software to automatically update drivers:

3. Fix errors using Windows' Repair feature.

You use a disc or USB Boot Windows 7, XP to put in the drive. Go to Setup when running the Windows disc. Then click the Repair feature to fix error 0xc00007b on Windows 7 and XP.



4. Reinstall Windows.

If none of the above methods work, install Windows 7 from scratch. Limit the use of pirated Windows versions, unlocked Ghost versions. to avoid repeating error 0x0000007b.

Reinstalling Windows will erase all data in your system drive, so before installing you should back up your data before installing a new copy of Windows.



Above are instructions on how to fix error 0x0000007b on Windows 7 and XP. Please follow each method to fix this error. In general, fixing error 0x0000007b, also known as Blue Screen of Death, is not too difficult, but to avoid encountering this error while using the computer, you need to be equipped with solid knowledge and foundation. .
