

Fix YouTube not automatically transferring songs on phones and computers

YouTube doesn't automatically change tracks on phones and computers, so you're very frustrated because you can't listen to music or watch videos continuously?

Youtube is an application loved and used by many smartphone and computer users. You can go to Youtube to watch movies, listen to music, watch animation, comedy, etc. The plus point of this application is that it has the feature of automatically switching to the next video when the video you are watching ends. Therefore, users do not need to turn it on again and again. However, nowadays many of you are encountering a situation where **Youtube does not automatically transfer songs on your phone and computer** . Surely you are wondering and don't know how to fix it. **TipsMake** will answer everything about this issue!





YouTube doesn't automatically transfer songs on phones and computers, why is that?

The autoplay video feature on Youtube is extremely convenient and popular with many users. Because when you finish watching the video, Youtube will automatically switch to the next related video. However, this feature is not always available. Many people have tried to turn on auto-play videos on YouTube on their phones and computers. The reasons why YouTube videos do not automatically transfer tracks on phones/computers are:

- 1. YouTube's autoplay video feature will be turned off by default for users between 13 and 17 years old. If you are 18 years old or older, this feature will be enabled by default. Therefore, if you are under 18 years old, it is possible that this feature has not been activated.*
- 2. During use, you accidentally turned off this feature so you did not turn on the auto-play mode for YouTube videos on your computer/phone.*
- 3. Youtube requires an internet connection to work. Therefore, it is possible that your device suddenly disconnected from the internet so it cannot continue to play videos.*
- 4. Besides, if users use 4G on their phone/computer. The video autoplay feature will automatically turn off if the user does not use the device for 30 minutes. If using wifi, the feature will automatically stop after 4 hours.*
- 5. If you are using a supervised account. It's likely that your parents have turned off the autoplay feature so you won't see the button to turn this feature on/off on Youtube.*

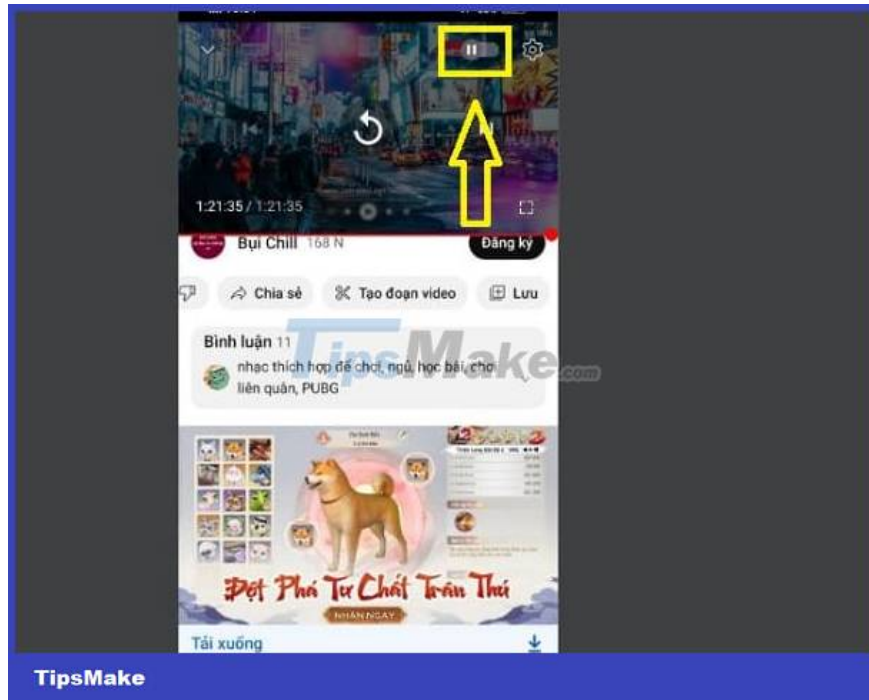


Instructions on how to fix when YouTube does not automatically transfer songs on phones and computers

If Youtube does not automatically forward the video, users should apply the tips below.

Share how to let YouTube automatically transfer songs on your phone

1. **Step 1** : *Access the Youtube application.*
2. **Step 2** : *Open any video you want to watch.*
3. **Step 3** : *When this video finishes playing, the next video icon will automatically appear on the video screen.*



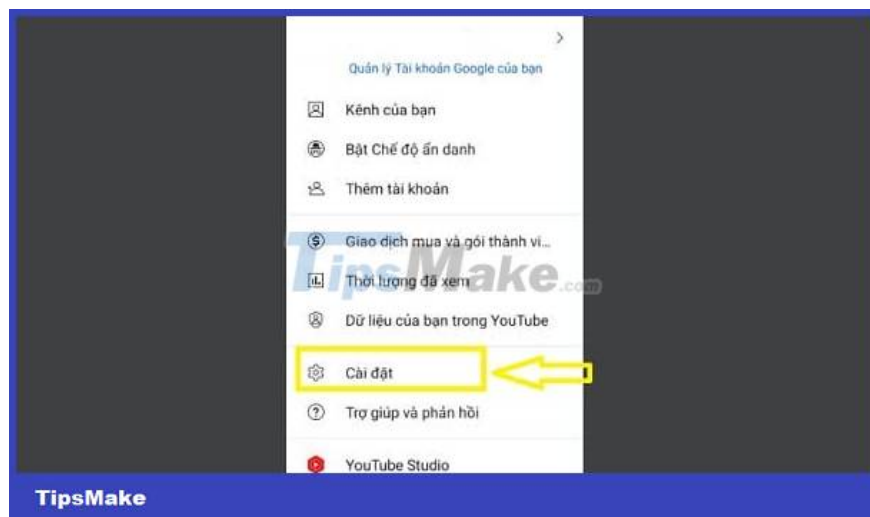
1. You just need to click on this icon to turn it on.

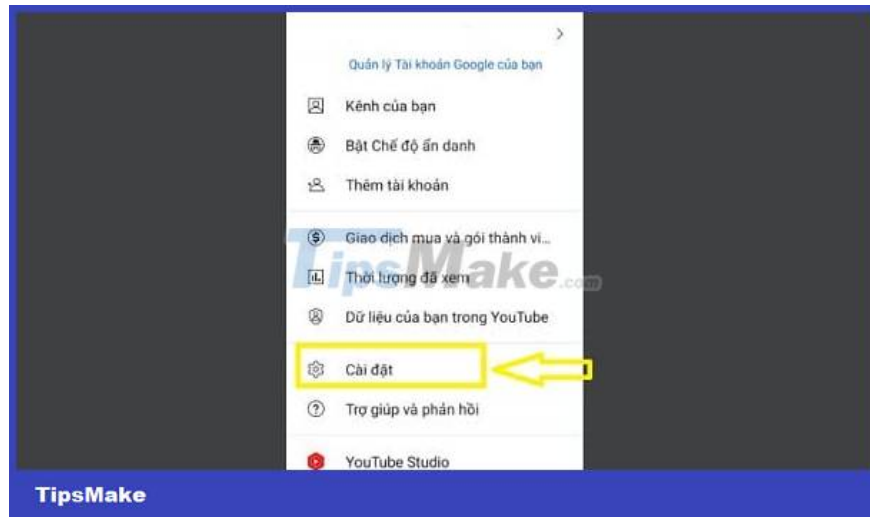




Besides, how to play videos continuously on YouTube can also be enabled in Settings as follows:

1. **Step 1** : Go to Youtube on your phone > Click on the avatar circle in the top right corner of your account.
2. **Step 2** : Scroll down and click **Settings** .

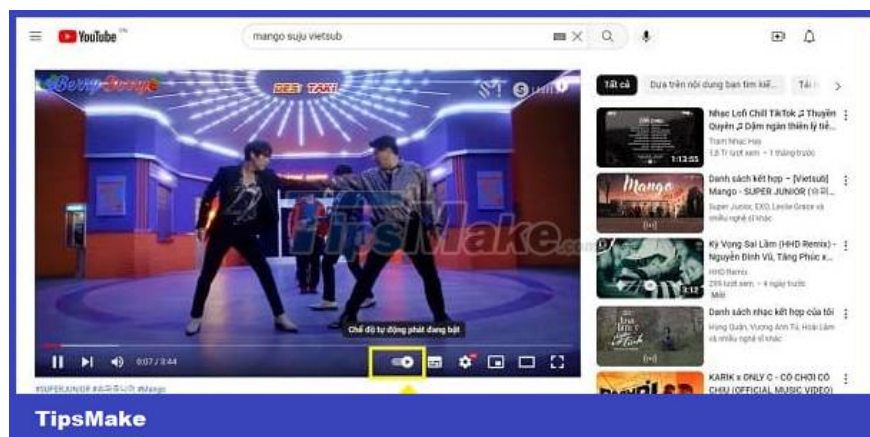




1. **Step 3** : Click on **Autoplay** .
2. **Step 4** : Activate the ' **Mobile phone/tablet** ' section.

Share how to let Youtube automatically transfer songs on your computer

1. **Step 1** : Go to YouTube on your computer > Open any video.
2. **Step 2** : On the toolbar of that video, you will see an icon that automatically plays the video. Click on it to turn it on (like the image below).





Check the internet connection on the device again

As the admin shared, for YouTube to run normally, there needs to be a network connection on the device. So, when I see YouTube doesn't automatically transfer songs on my computer/phone. First, please try checking your internet connection again. It's possible that the connection was disconnected or the network was too weak so YouTube didn't work properly.

In addition, after a period of time as I mentioned in the first part, the autoplay feature will stop. Therefore, you just need to go to Youtube and allow the video to continue playing.
