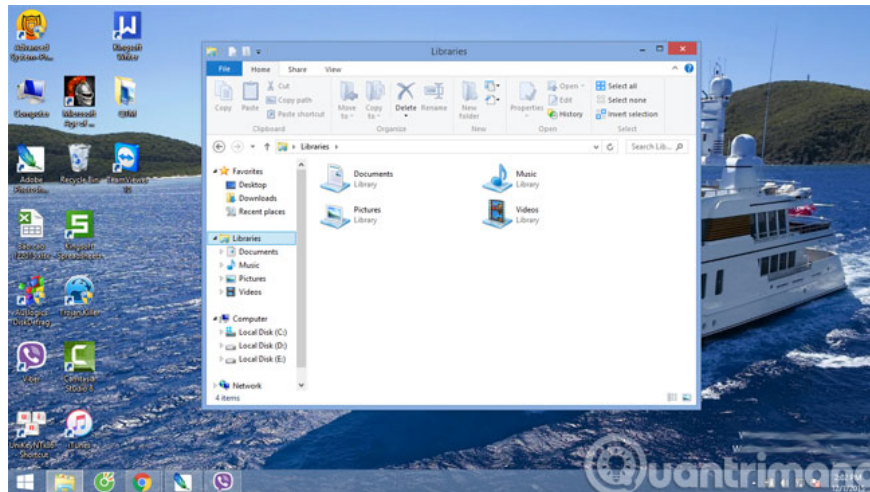


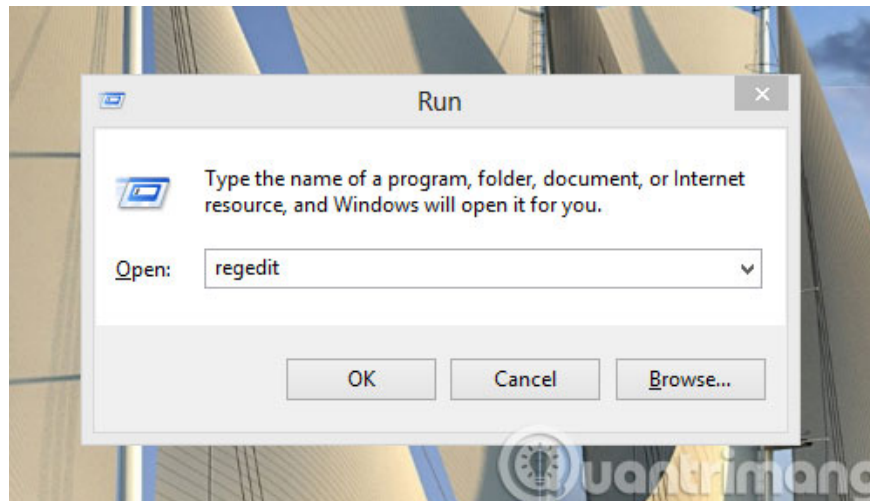
Fixed a bug when Libraries folder opened automatically when booting the computer

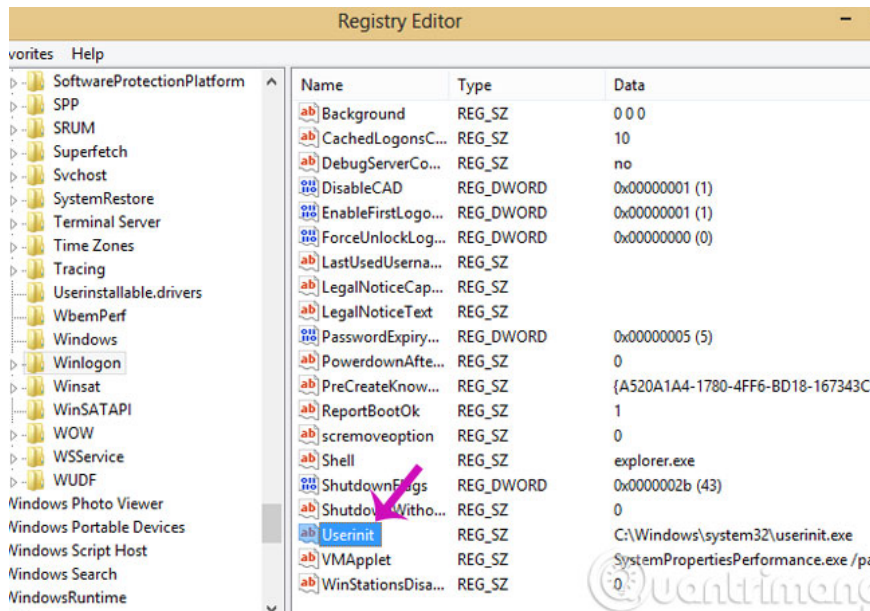

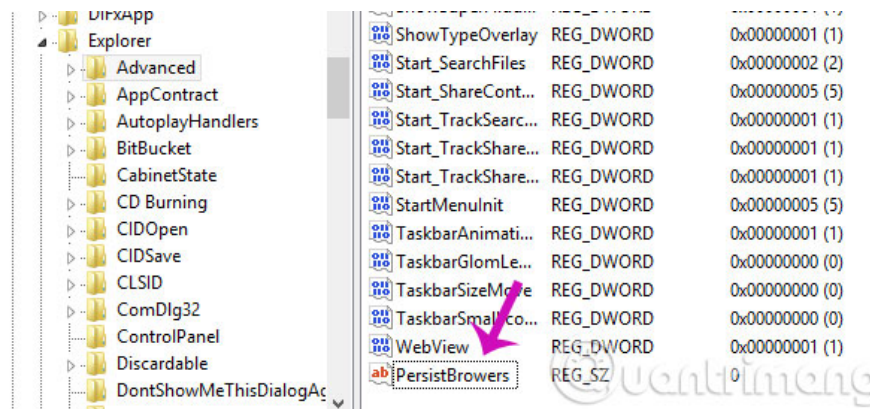
Step 1 : Press the **Windows + R** key combination and then enter the **Regedit** command to open the **Registry** dialog box .



Step 2 : When the **Registry Editor** dialog box opens, go to the following path of **HKEY_LOCAL_MACHINE SOFTWARE Microsoft Windows NT CurrentVersion Winlogon** and fix **Userinit** key to **C:\Windows\system32\userinit.exe**



Step 3 : You go to the following link **HKEY_CURRENT_USER Software Microsoft Windows CurrentVersion Explorer Advanced** . In the right corner, you find the value of **PersistBrowsers** and convert it to **0** . If you don't see this key, you can create it by right-clicking it and selecting **New > Sting value** , entering the **PersistBrowsers** key and entering the value = **0** .



Finally, turn off the Registry and restart the computer.
