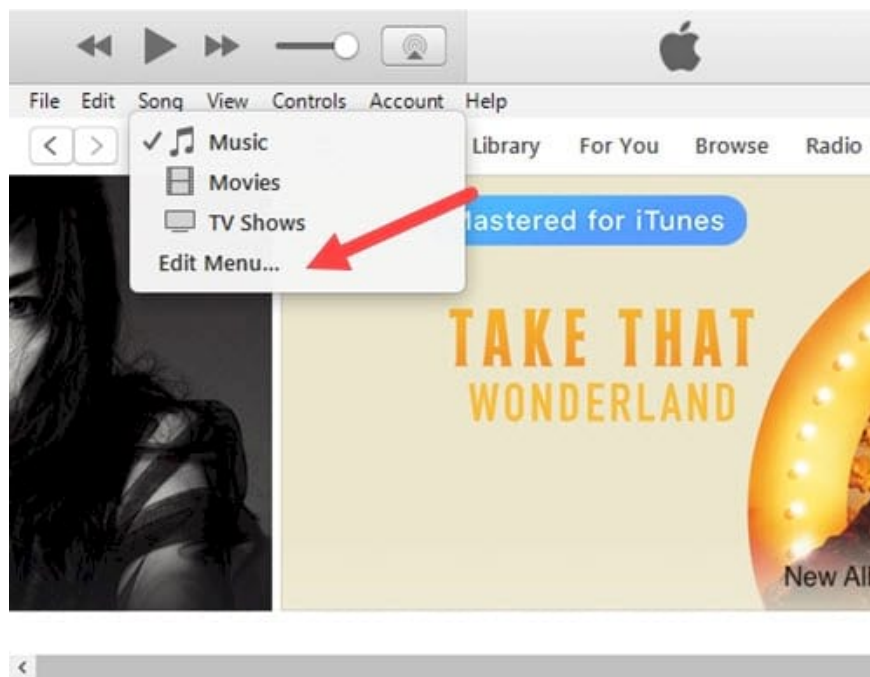

This guide explains why you might not see the Tones ringtone option in iTunes when setting a ringtone on your iPhone .

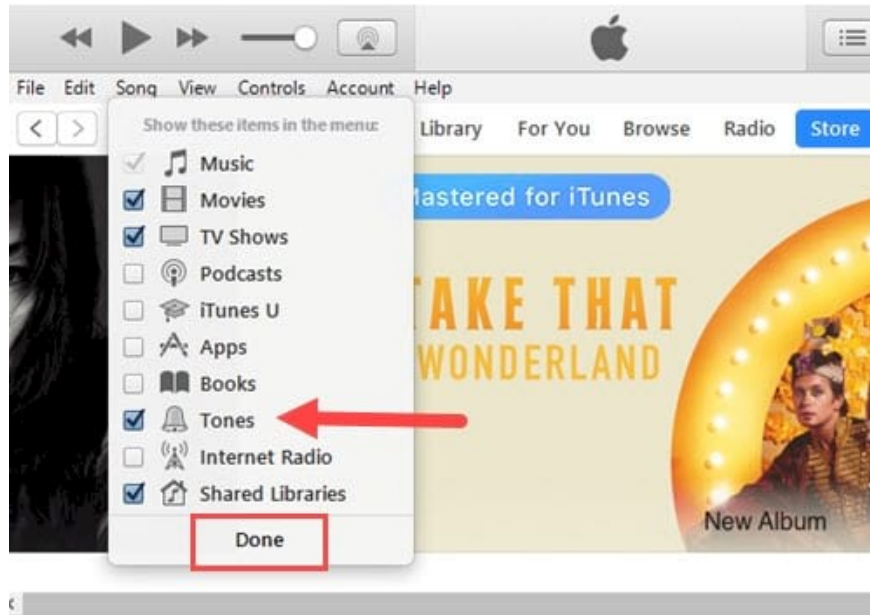
Step 1: First, open iTunes . On the iTunes interface, you will see a section called **Music** .



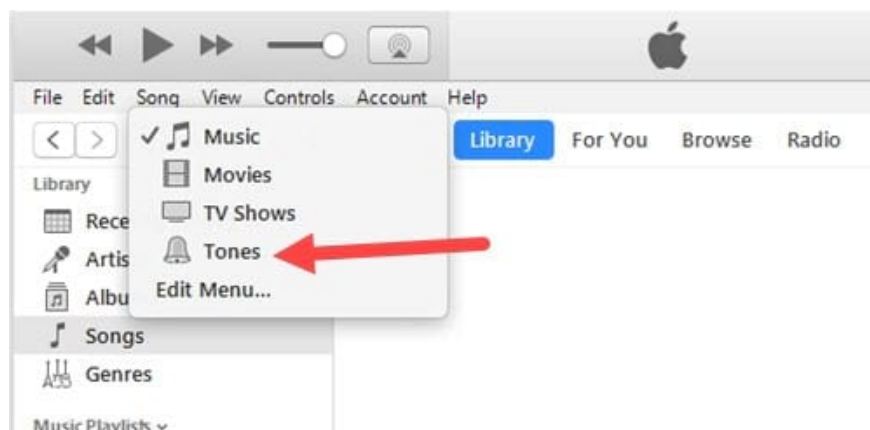
Step 2: Click on it and you will see three default items displayed: **Music** , **Movies** , and **TV Shows**. Select the fourth option, **Edit Menu** ., to customize the display.



Step 3: A complete list will now appear. You can uncheck or add as you wish. Of course, we must check the **Tones box** and then click **Done** .



Step 4: Then, reopen the list and you will see the Tones section appear. This means the error of not seeing the Tones ringtone section in iTunes has been completely resolved.



Clicking on it will give us an overview of all the ringtones we have or have created on iTunes.
