

# Forget the iPhone 8 or iPhone X, hear the iPhone next year is much more attractive

It's true that the iPhone 8 and iPhone X are great, but should you wait until next year's iPhone to upgrade it?

It's true that the iPhone 8 and iPhone X are great, but should you wait until next year's iPhone to upgrade it?

In short, if you need a new phone to use every day because the old one is too slow, it's time to upgrade. Just choose the right one, iPhone SE, 6S, 7, 8 or X are all right, don't think of iPhone next year.

But if you look forward to interesting things, here are the first rumors about this phone. The rumor is now only focused on the iPhone screen, that the design will have a big change, at least compared to the iPhone 8. It is not known what the new phone will be, iPhone 8S or iPhone 9 so from now on temporarily call iPhone 2018.

So remember this is just an initial speculation, it's too early to say anything and Apple can change it because there's plenty of time to actually launch in September next year.

## **The successor of the iPhone 8 will be nearly without the bezel**

According to the Wall Street Journal, upcoming mid-range iPhones will have virtually no front bezel, as well as iPhone X.

Specifically, Apple seems to be targeting a type of LCD monitor called Full Active LCD manufactured by Japan Display. You can temporarily imagine how the Full Active LCD screen looks like through the Essential Phone (below) or Xiaomi Mi Mix 2.

One thing to note is that unlike the OLED display of the iPhone X, they often have a little bit of a big bezel, usually at the bottom.

This type of LCD monitor will be cheaper and probably will have less supply problems than OLED being used by iPhone X, two factors that contribute to the price of iPhone X so high.

**One of the 2018 iPhone phones has screens up to 6 inches wide**

According to the Korea Herald, Apple ordered Japan Display for a 6-inch LCD screen. Because it is LCD panel, not OLED, this will be the successor of iPhone 8 Plus, not iPhone X.

**If the iPhone 2-18 has almost no bezel, this means the end of the iPhone 6 era design**

This is just a guess based on the rumor that Apple will use the Full Active LCD screen, one of which is said to be larger than the 5.5-inch screen of the iPhone 8 Plus. Meanwhile, the iPhone 2018 looks very different, no big bezel on the iPhone 8, which is the design from the iPhone 6 launched in 2014.

### **iPhone X's successor in 2018 will also be bigger**

According to ET News, Apple ordered Samsung Display, the manufacturer of OLED displays of iPhone X, for OLED screens 5.28, 5.85 and 6.46 inches, but the smallest size was canceled.

Rumor has it that Apple will bring more 6.46-inch screens to iPhone X's successor next year. The coming iPhone X this month only has a 5.8-inch OLED display.
