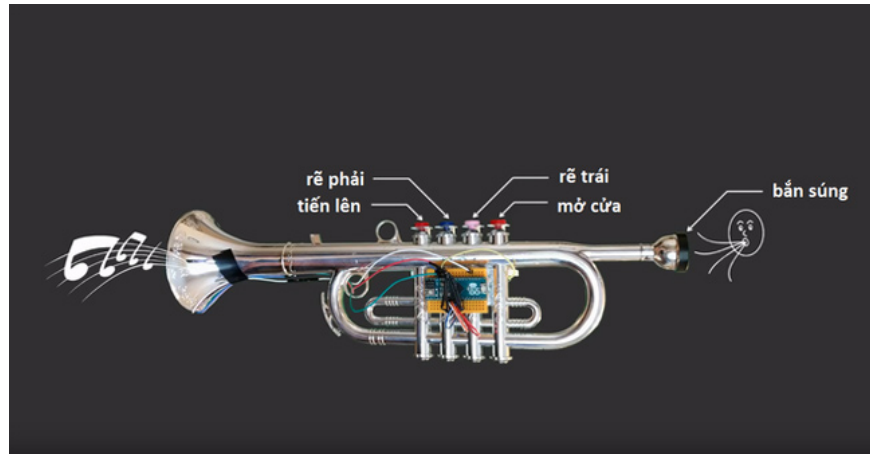
Doom is a legendary game of first-person shooter (FPS), although it has been around for nearly ten years but Doom still attracts a large number of players.
