Choose A VPN Wisely

When we travel abroad, we may need to access our accounts in our home country. In order to do so, virtual private networks may be necessary. These are programs that redirect our IP addresses, making it seem like we are logging on from a different place.

Some of these will be more secure than others. Some will scramble your IP address, for example, encrypting it and making your identity less public. Others will not. It is important to do some research into which one will best fit your needs and to ask yourself how much you are willing to shell out in order to receive which protections.

Some of the free options are likely to leave you at least a little exposed. given that we use these to log in to your most sensitive accounts, it is important to give this aspect a good amount of attention.
