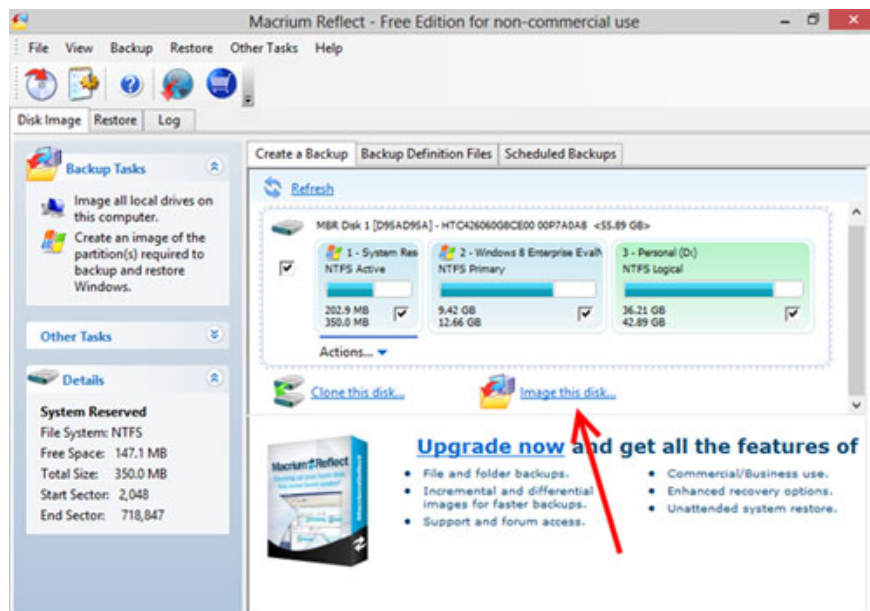

Macrium Reflect Free

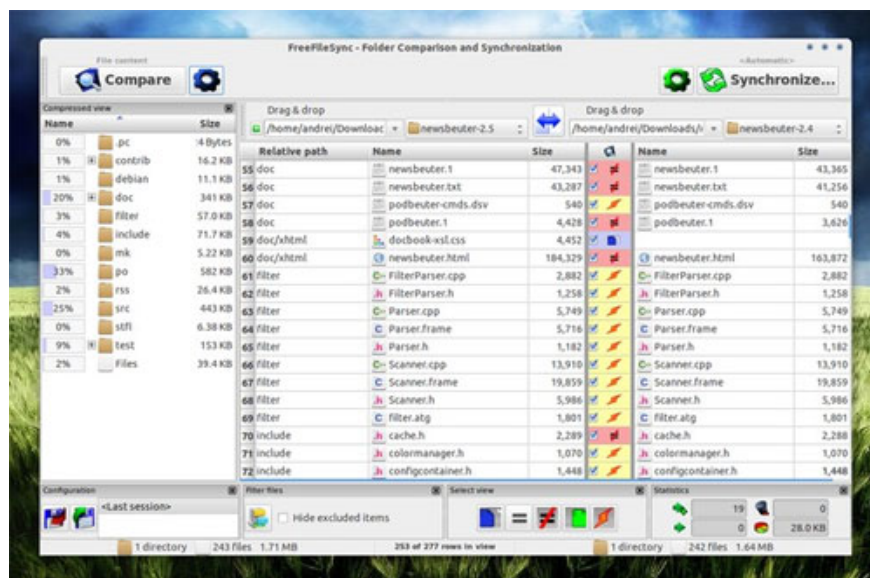

FreeFileSync

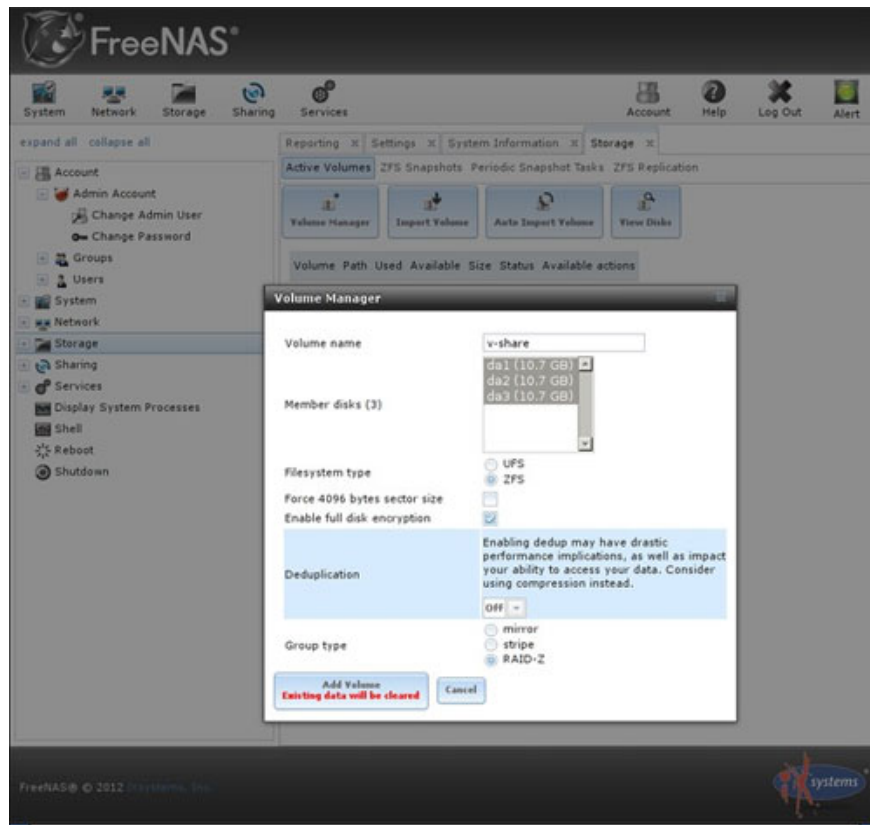
