Fujitsu's new 3D notebook, called the **LifeBook AH572** , possesses very noticeable specifications, the most attractive of which is the ability to support 3D technology.

The *LifeBook AH572* 's 3D display has a size of 15.6 inches, a resolution of 1366 x 768 pixels, equipped with a 3D Xpol filter.

In terms of interior, the *LifeBook AH572* uses a 2.3 GHz Intel Core i5-2410M processor, integrated Intel HD 3000 graphics, along with 4 GB of DDR3 RAM and 500 GB of hard drive storage , the 6-cell battery has a duration of up to 7 hours, integrated 1.3-megapixel webcam and can record 3D videos.

LifeBook AH572 was launched by Fujitsu at a price of 999 USD.
