

Galaxy S10 + has a production cost of about 420 USD, the most expensive screen

According to TechInsights, the total cost for Samsung to produce this flagship S10 + is about \$ 420 (about 9.8 million), approximately 40% of the price of the device (starting price from 999USD, about 23 , VND 2 million).

Galaxy S10 + is Samsung smartphone equipped with all the new technology, the company's most advanced. S10 + version uses Exynos processor, 8GB of RAM and 128GB ROM.

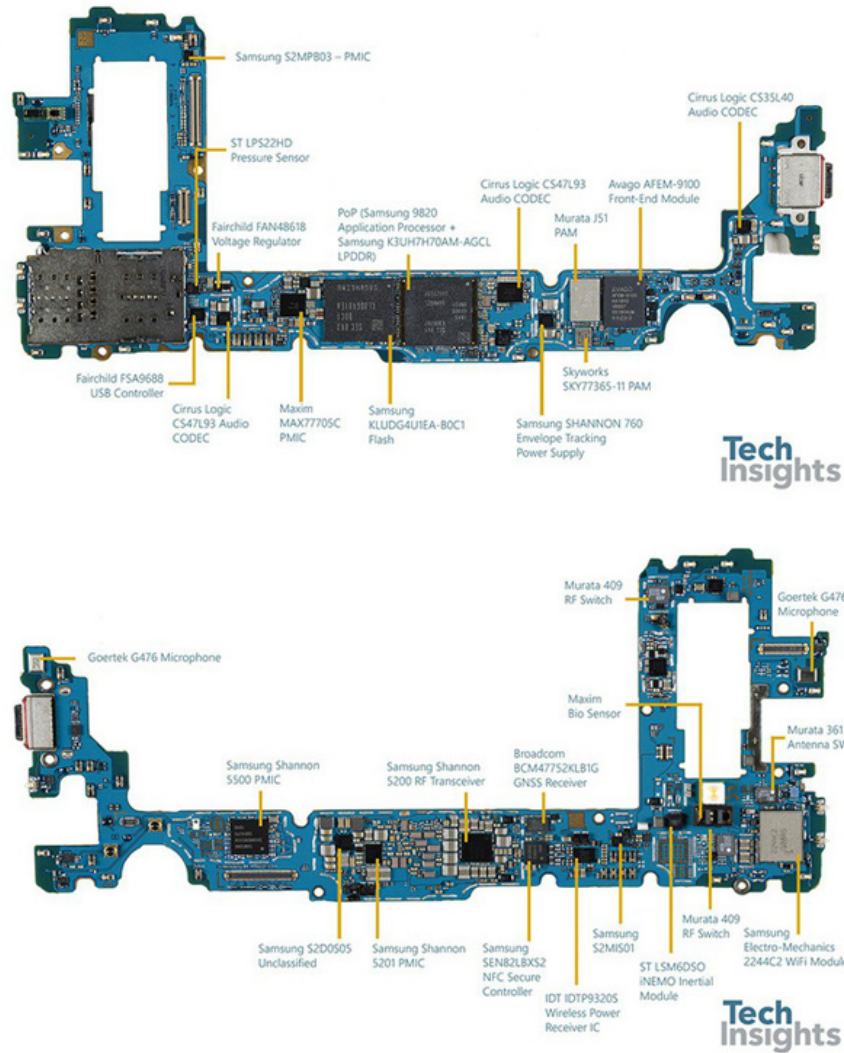
According to TechInsights, the total cost for Samsung to produce this flagship S10 + is about \$ 420 (about 9.8 million), approximately 40% of the price of the device (starting price from 999USD, about 23 , VND 2 million).

The following chart will give you the full details of the cost of each component to build the Galaxy S10 +.



Specifically, the most expensive component of the S10 + is the screen (produced on a complex screen technology with high-end panels), for up to 86.5 USD (about 2 million VND). Right after that, the chipset costs \$ 70.5.

The system of 5 cameras on S10 + is also quite expensive at 56.5 USD. The memory is equipped with 8GB of RAM / 128GB of internal memory, higher than the Galaxy S9 + but remains at the price of \$ 50.5.

420USD is just the cost of manufacturing parts to assemble an S10 +, not including the cost of research, marketing, shipping, import tax .
