Are you wondering if your iPhone is still under warranty? Checking the warranty period helps you plan for maintenance or repairs. The following guide will help you check easily.

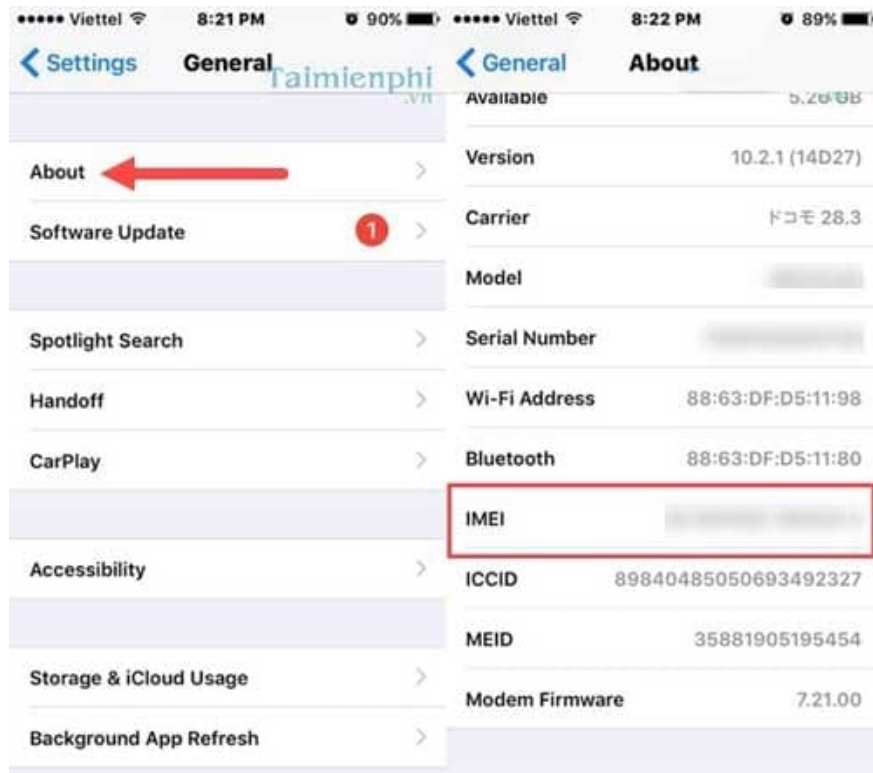
How to accurately check your iPhone warranty

Step 1: Obtain the IMEI number from your device.

Open your iPhone and access Settings . Once you're in Settings , select **General** .



Step 2: After accessing the settings, select **General** . At the top of the menu bar, you will see an **About** section . Click on it to view all the information about your iPhone, including its IMEI.

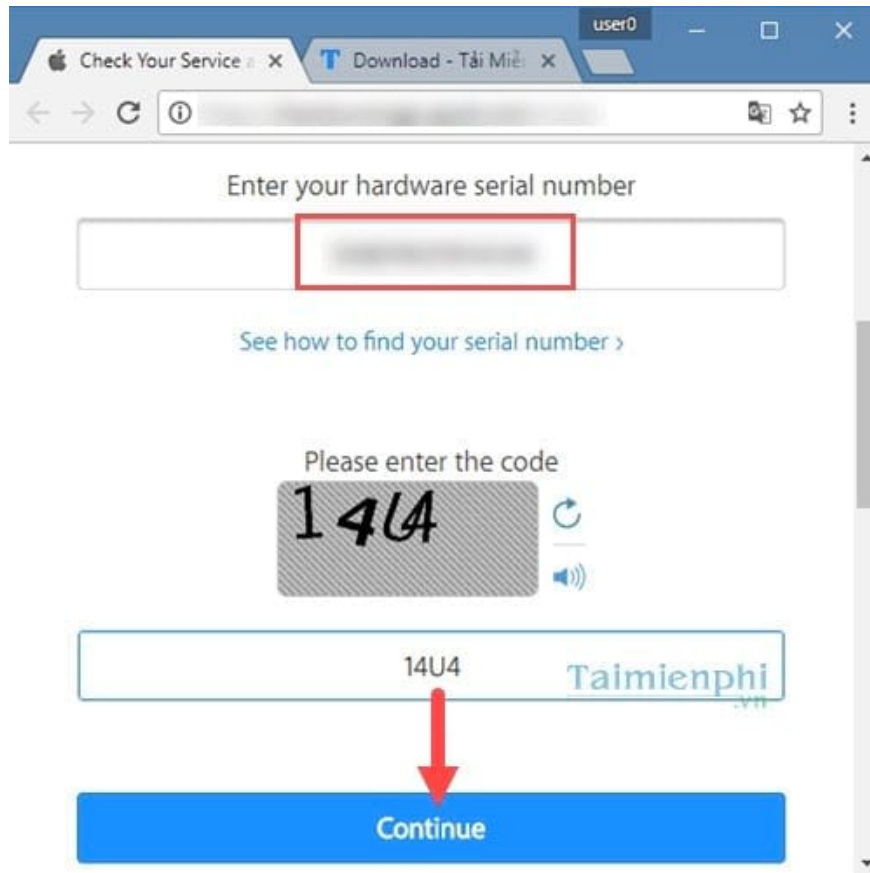


- Another faster way to check your IMEI is to tap the Phone app on your iPhone screen and type ***06#** ; the IMEI will appear immediately.



Step 3: After obtaining the IMEI code, click [HERE](#) .

Step 4: Enter the IMEI number you just obtained, fill in the correct captcha code, and then press **Continue** to view the device information.



Step 5: Information about the device will appear immediately. In the **Repair and Service Convergence** section , if it says "**Expired,**" it means your device is out of warranty.
