

# Gmail allows users to send emails in emails

Gmail will allow users to attach emails to other emails.

According to a recent announcement by Google, Gmail will allow users to attach email in other emails. This means that users can send emails in email as attachments, instead of having to forward or download as before.

Google adds that it will make the feature available to users over the next two weeks.
