1. Origin of Vu Lan holidays

Vu Lan ceremony comes from the book of Bodhisattva Section of the Past. Section Kien Lien is one of the ten disciples of the Buddha, whose mother is Ms. De De.

The old story told that, during the time of birth, the mother of bodhisattva Section Kien Lien did many evil things, insulting the monks, so when she died, she was banished to hell to make the ghost hungry.

Bodhisattva Section Kien Lien tried to save her mother. He was told by the Buddha how to worship monks on the occasion of the Full Moon in July and thanks to the blessings of the numerous monks, they could save their mother from suffering and torture in hell.



Following the Buddha's words, the mother of Section Kien Lien was liberated. Buddha also taught that sentient beings who want to inform their parents also should in this way (Vu Lan Bon Phap). Since then, Vu Lan's day was born.

Accordingly, on the occasion of July every year, Buddhists organize offerings, offering offerings to the Three Jewels to pray for grandparents and parents to be escaped. It is a form of filial piety for lost family members.

Accordingly, the 2017 Vu Lan Festival falls on Tuesday, September 5, 2017 (15/7 lunar calendar).
