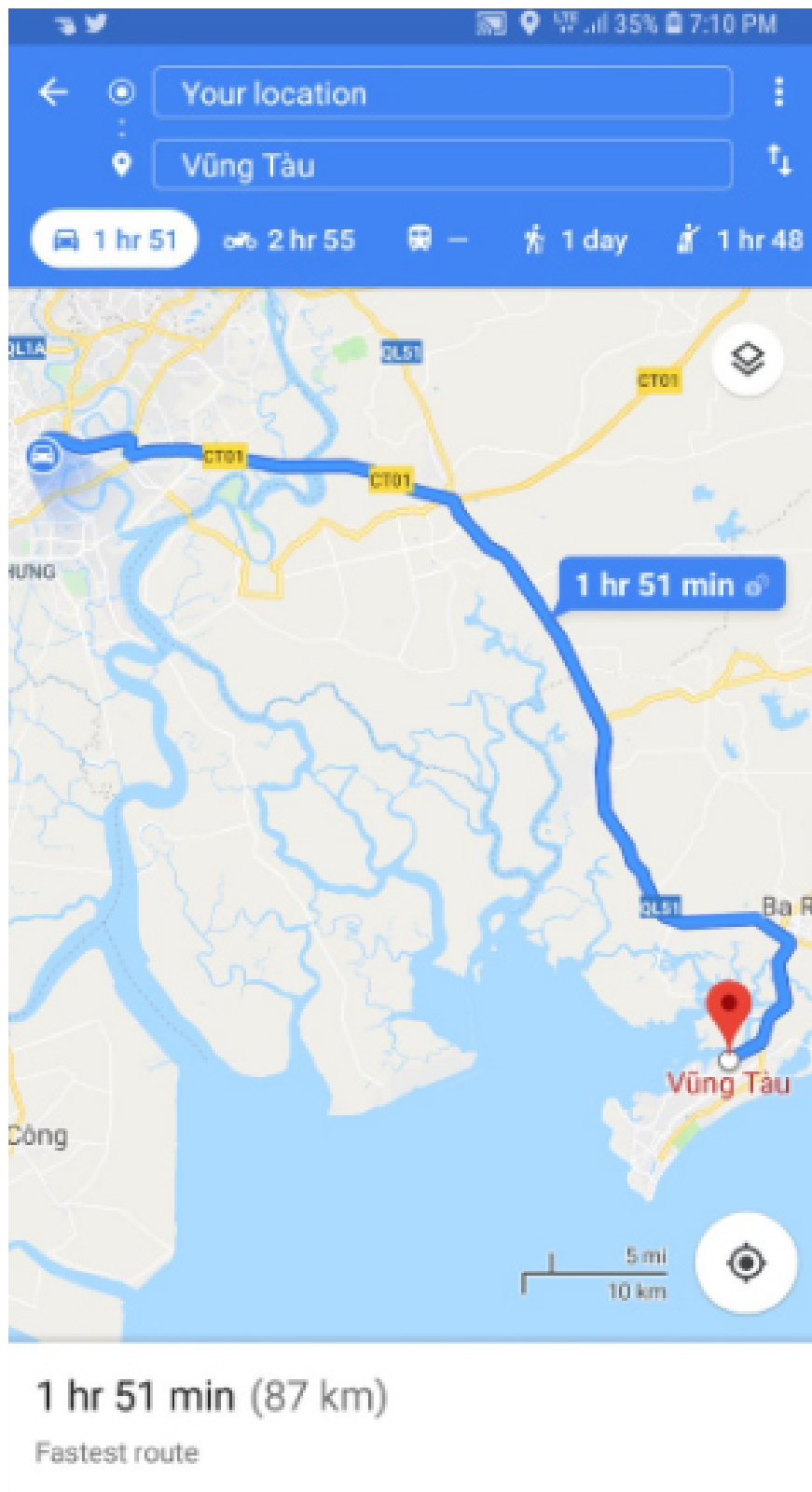


# Good news: Google Maps has supported navigation for motorcycles in Vietnam

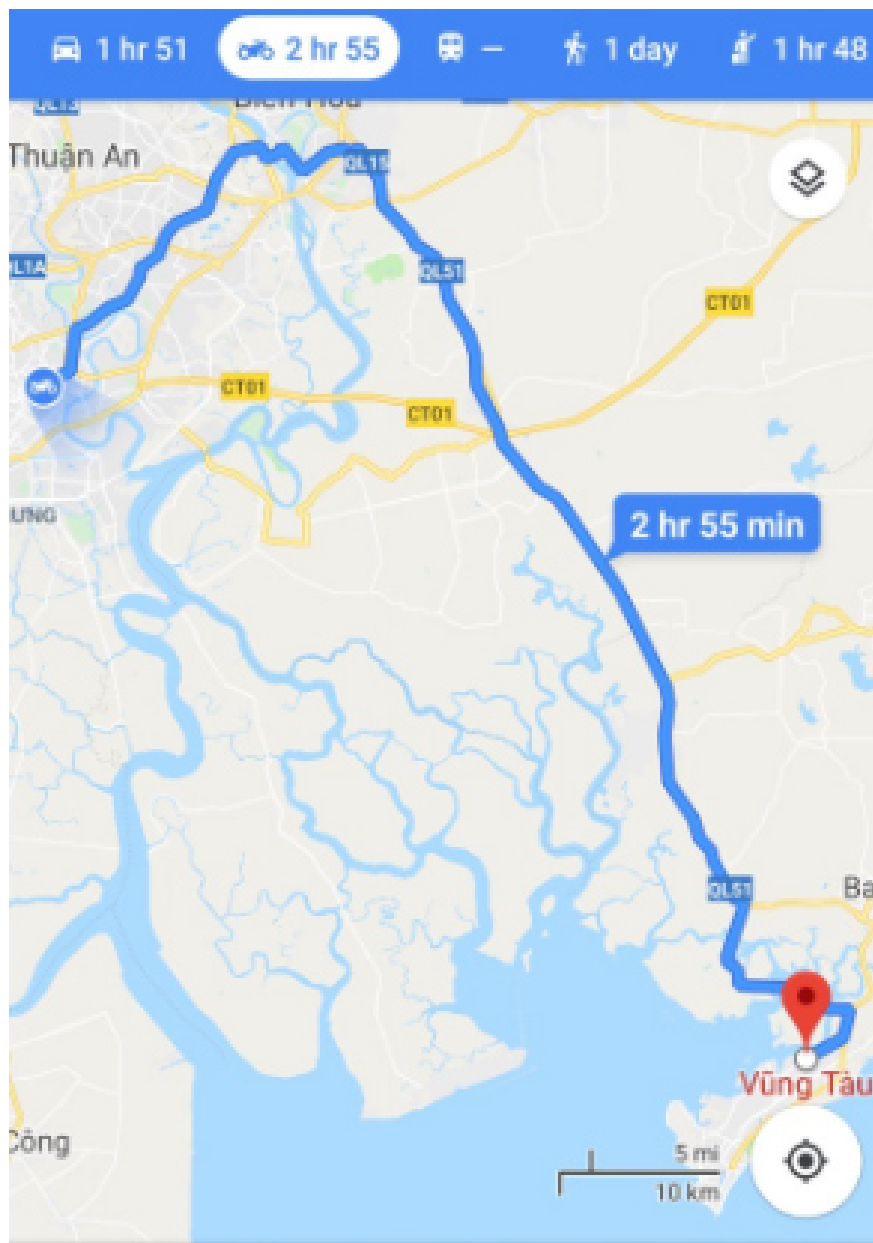
