

Google added a new feature to Google Photos

Google has added more powerful photo and video editing to Google Photos, which is often found on new Pixel phones. This feature will now also be available on other devices in the near future.

On both Android and iOS platforms, Google regularly adds advanced editing features for Google Photos. Features exclusive to Pixel phones will now be available on other Android devices when users subscribe to a paid Google One plan.

Paid editing features have been rumored for some time, but only now Google announced. Specifically, Google is offering some AI-enabled editing tools like enhanced Portrait Blur, Portrait Light, and Color Pop that Google started offering with the Pixel 5 last year.

With the "Dynamic" option, Google says, users can enhance the brightness and contrast on an image as needed, for a more balanced, impressive shot. And with sky recommendations, users can make their images stand out by enhancing and adjusting the colors and contrast in the sky with one of the sunrise-inspired palettes and sunset.
