To bring John Legend's voice to Google Assistant, WaveNet artificial intelligence model engineers had to train their deep neural networks with John Legend's voice recordings for months. Besides, in order to ensure the most natural and authentic voice as possible, post-processing was paid special attention by Google engineers.

First introduced in 2017 by DeepMind, AI WaveNet model has been used to create all 6 voice options currently used on Google Assistant.

It is clear that John Legend's appearance on Google Assistant is just the beginning of Google's plan with the ambition of bringing more famous singers and actors to their virtual assistant platform. Bringing a long list of familiar voice options can be an effective way to expand the user's options to personalize Google Assistant according to each person's preferences. Besides, creating AI assistants that match the mood or personality of the user can also be another promising step in this direction.
