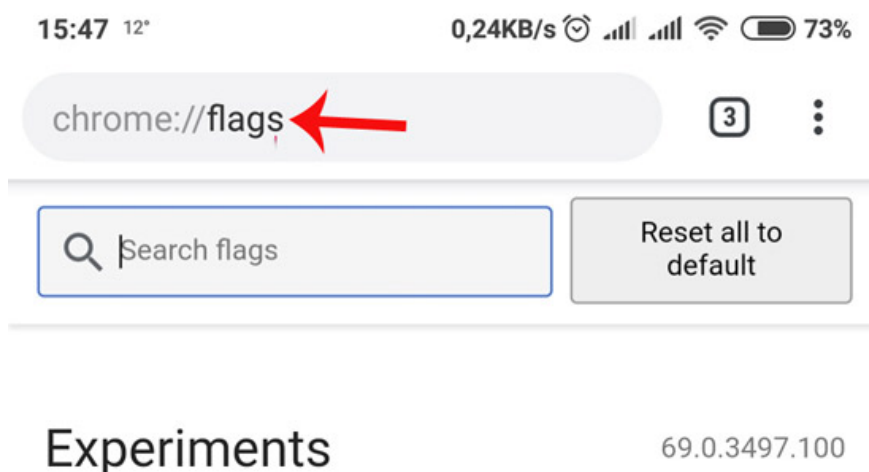
From now on, users can activate the new interface for Google Chrome and experience by following the instructions below.

Step 2: Open the Chrome browser, copy the "chrome: // flags" path into the address bar and press Enter to access the activation features page that is only for developers or hidden.



Step 3: Enter the search box for keywords to explore-sites. At Explore websites, select Enabled -> click on Relaunch now to restart the browser and apply the new interface.

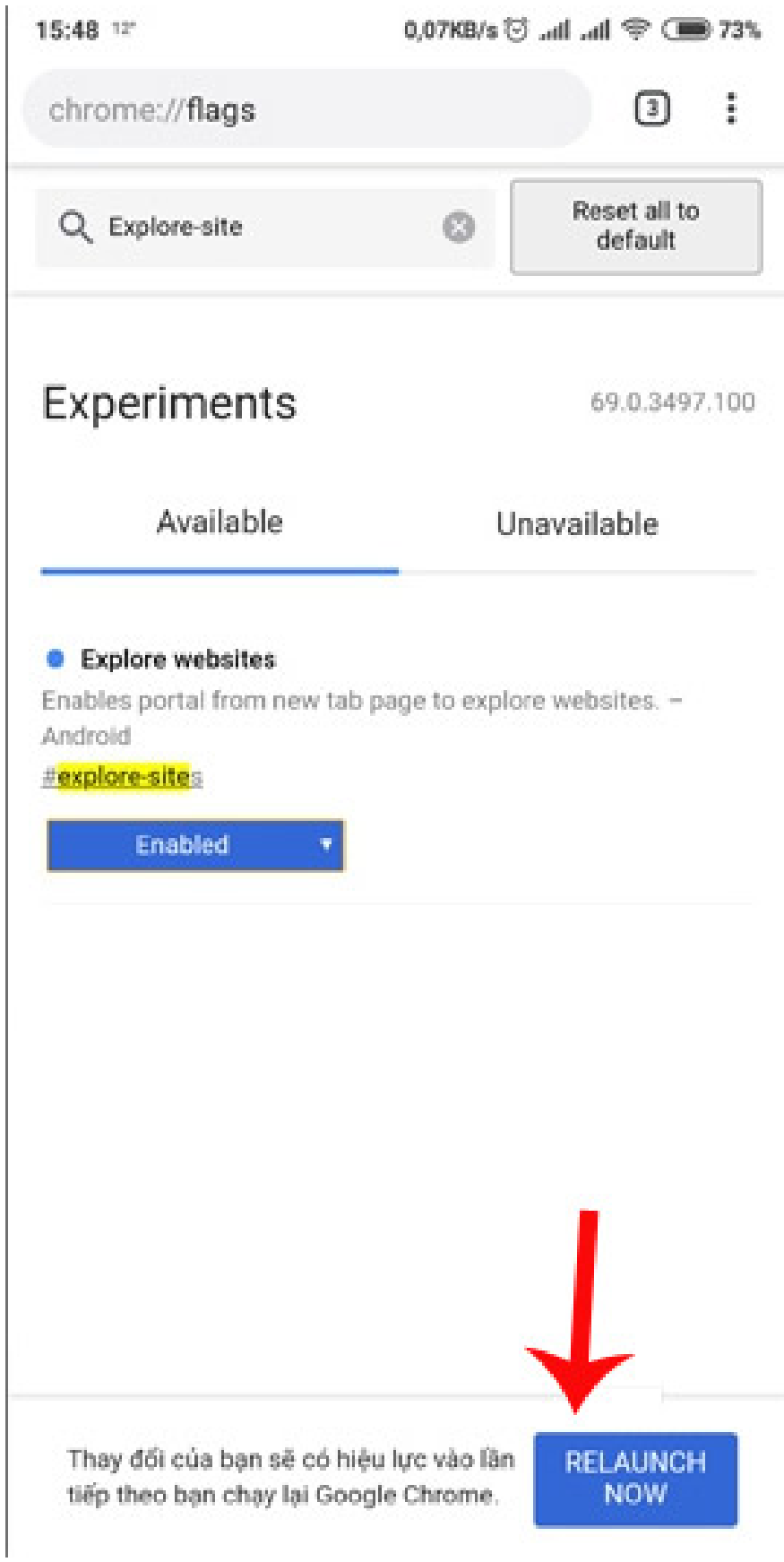

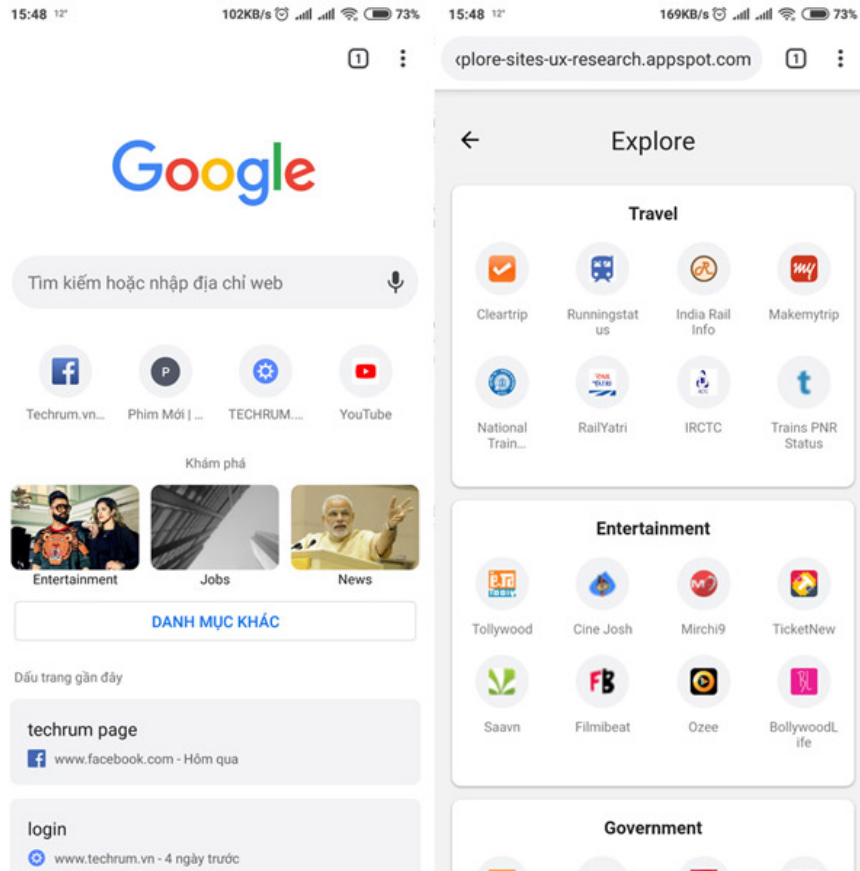
