Google improved its support for Microsoft's Active Directory system on Chrome Enterprise. With this update, administrators will be able to use objects in the Group Policy group to configure managed Chrome utilities and users can authenticate directly to Kerberos and NTLMv2 endpoints on the local Internet. the set.

A new feature will require previously managed devices to automatically re-register in the system, even after deleting or restoring. That way, users can reconnect to the management system without using administrator credentials.

Currently, Google has also announced a partnership with Cisco Meraki, IBM MaaS360, Citrix XenMobile and Zoho Mobile Device Manager Plus that allow IT administrators to manage their Chrome Enterprise devices from the central control panel.
