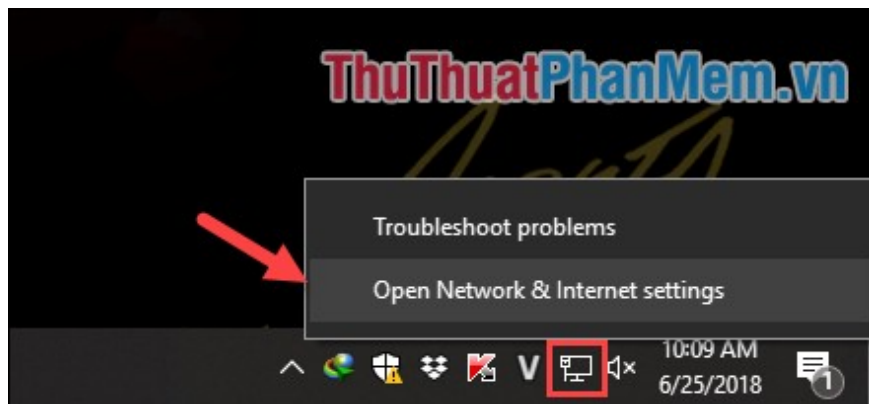

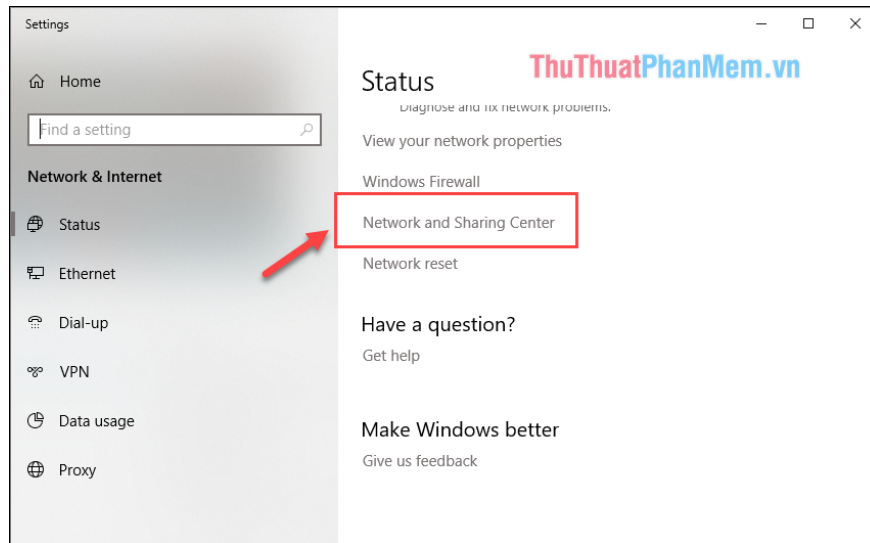

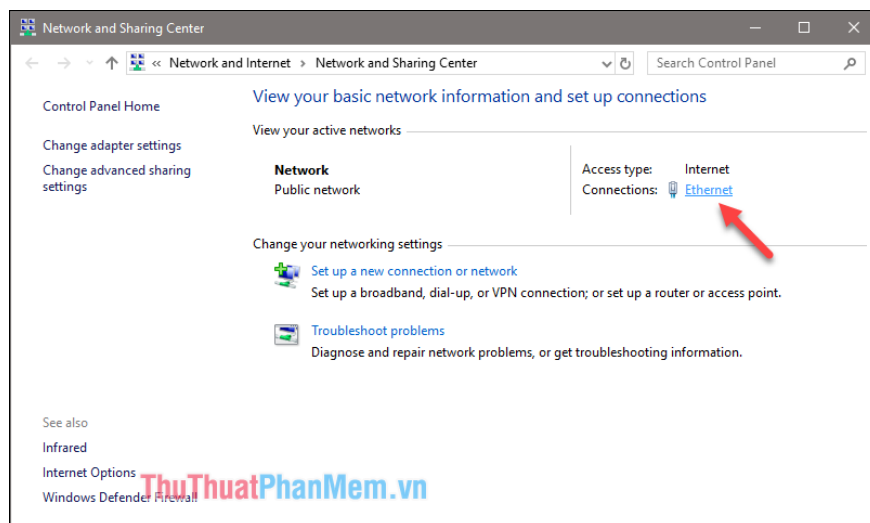
Step 1: Right-click on the internet connection icon and then select **Open Network & Internet settings**.



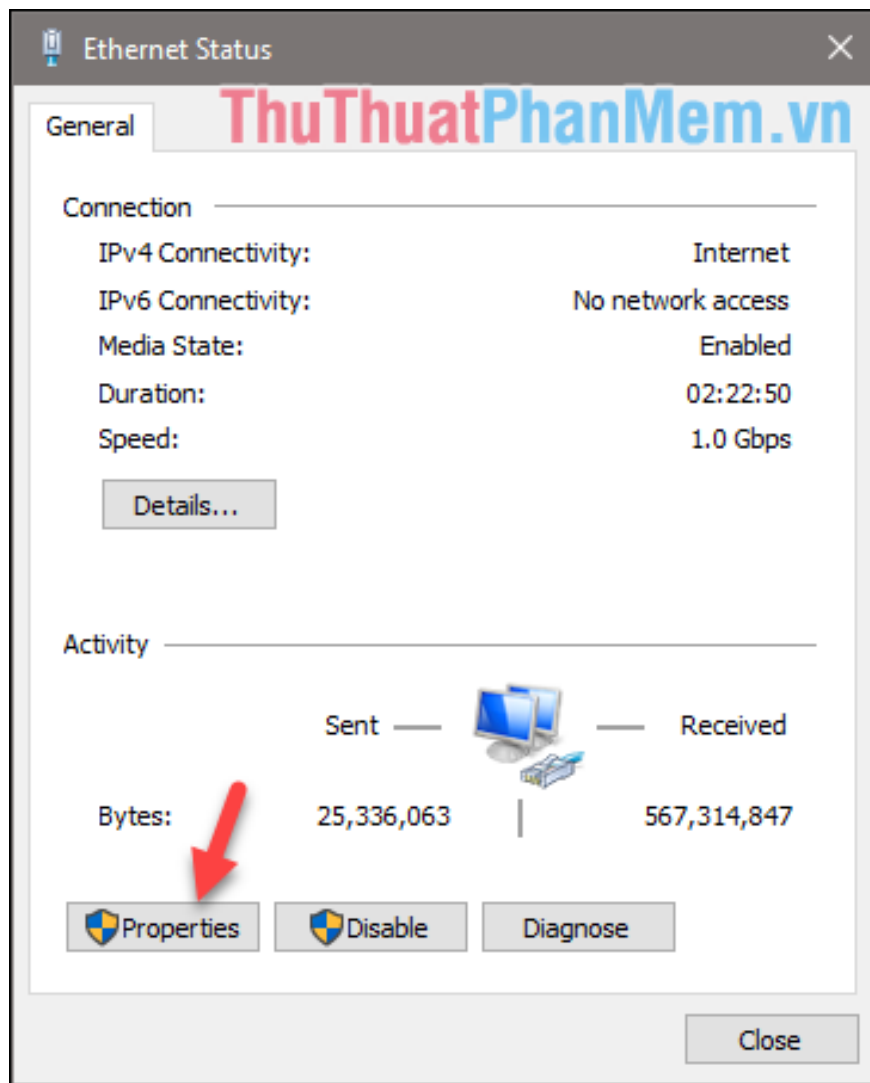
Step 2: The settings window appears, scroll down and select **Network and Sharing Center**.



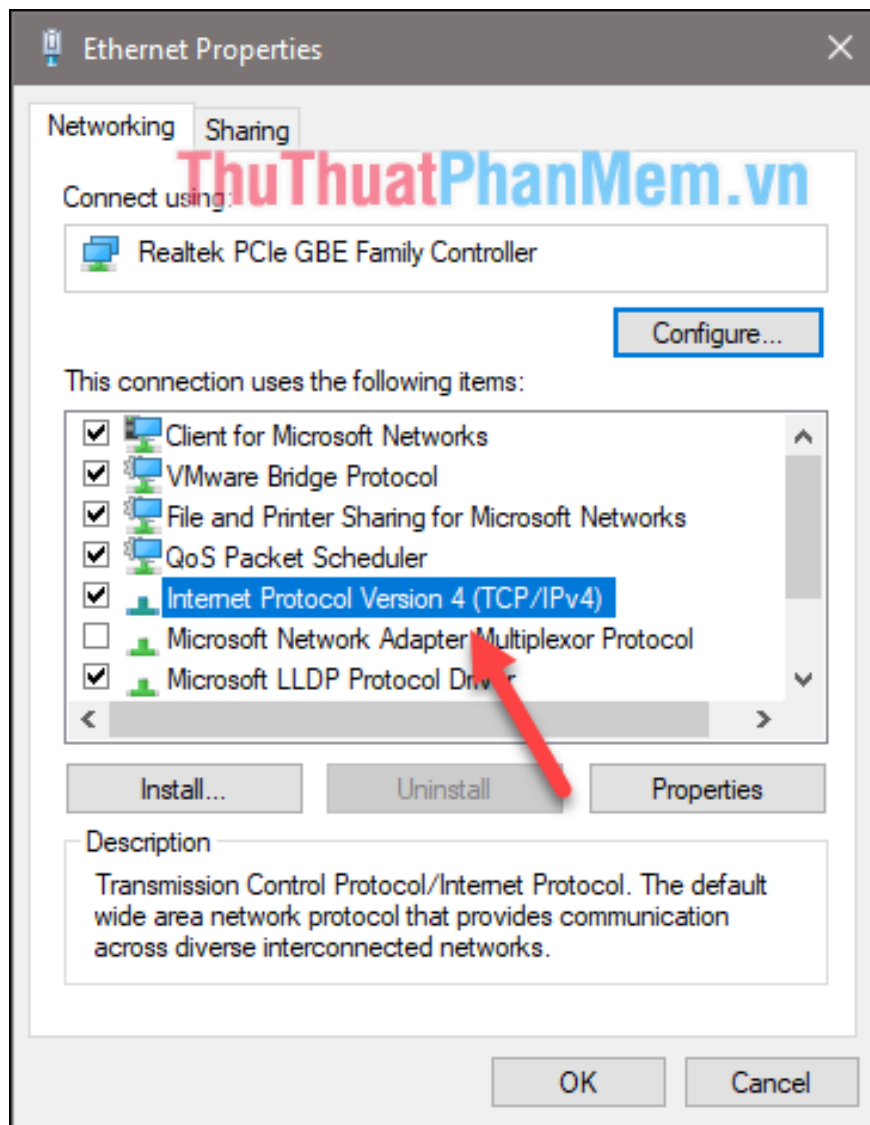
Step 3 : Click on the name of the **Connections** .



Step 4 : A new window appears, select **Properties**.

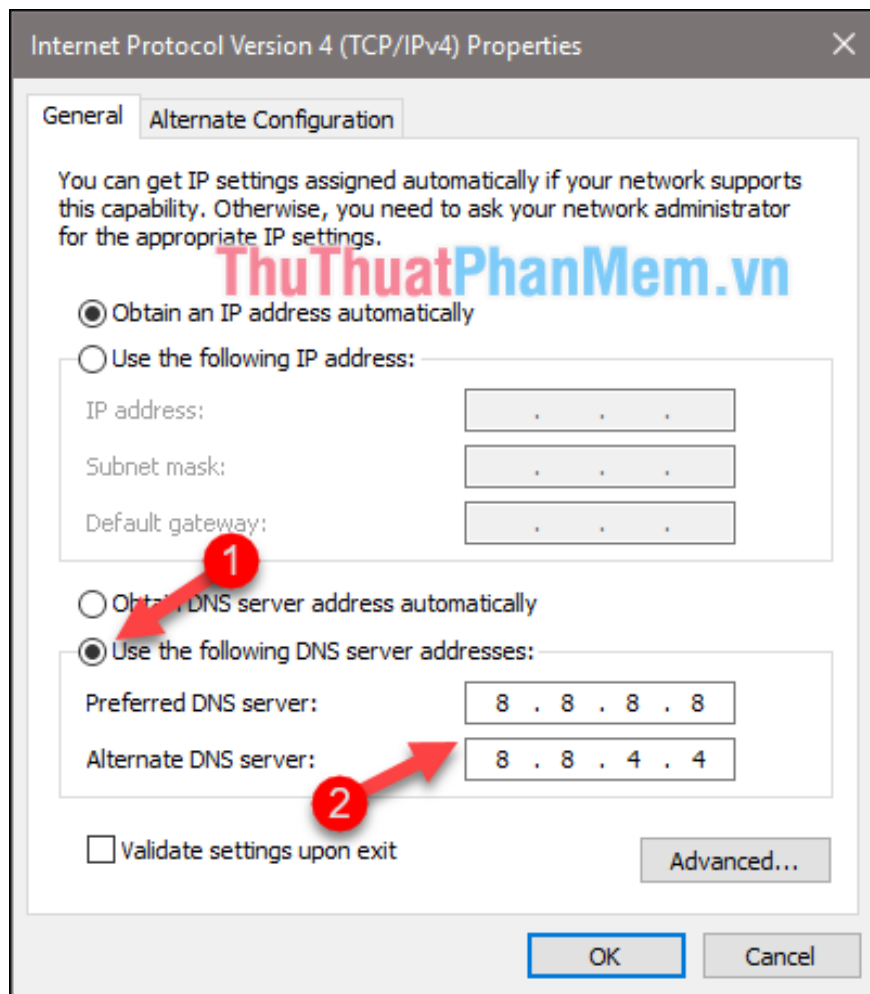


Step 5 : Double click on **Internet Protocol Version 4 (TCP / Ipv4)**.
