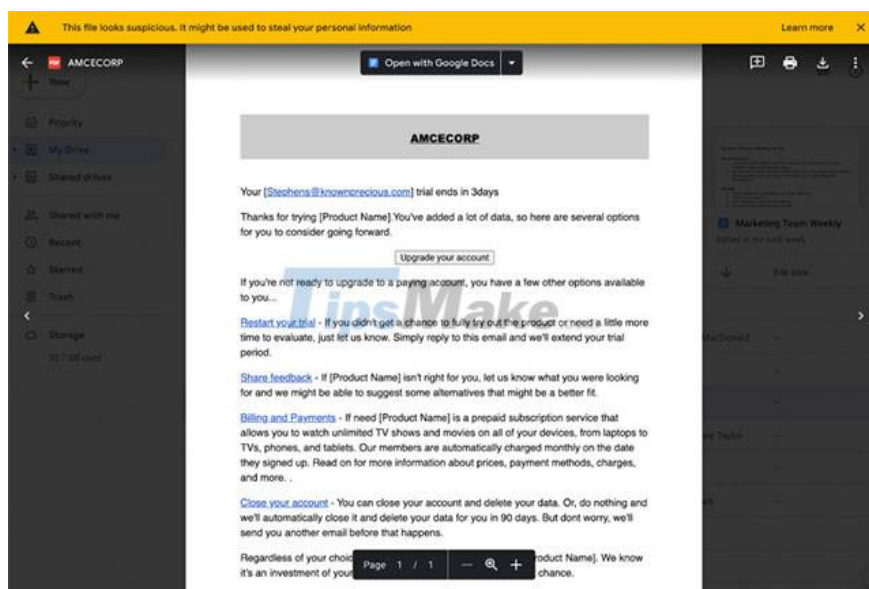


Google Drive is being added a very useful new security feature
