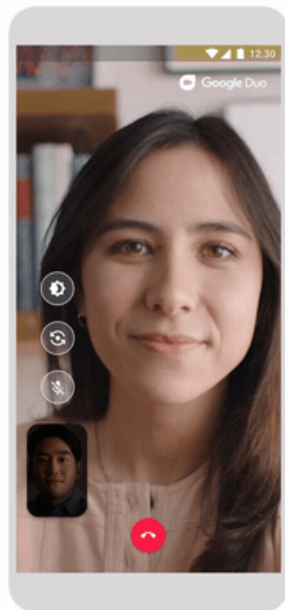


Google Duo adds a new feature that allows video calling in the dark without turning on the light

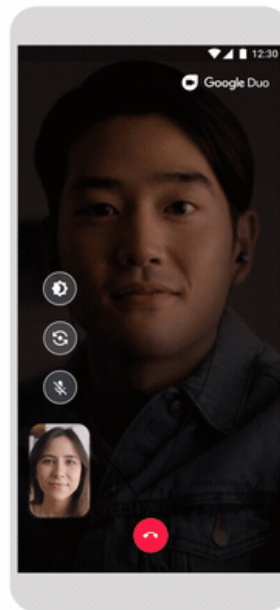

The brightness control feature in the video chat application has appeared in some applications (such as Skype) but only allows users to adjust the settings manually. In Google Duo, users can choose to switch to automatic

brightness adjustment of the video in the call to manually adjust to the optimal settings.

Google said that this feature will benefit users who want to save electricity and users who have problems with electric lights, such as some people in a space illuminated only by electric light bulbs. only.
